### DRIFTONE Lace Beret



<u>Rnd 8:</u> K across. Rep these 8 rnds for pattern st. Approximate Measurements after blocking 18" Brim, 24" circumference

#### <u>Materials:</u> Driftone:

2—50g balls, color 02 Grey Tone Gauge: 24 sts, 32 rows= 4" in st st and <u>Horseshoe Lace on US Size 5 (3.75mm)</u> *after blocking*, Needles: US Size 3 (3.25mm) 5 (3.75mm)-24" Circular, US Size 5 (3.75mm) DPNs, 1 st marker (m).

Work either the charted or the written instructions for the <u>Horsehoe Lace</u> and <u>Horseshoe Lace Decrease Chart</u>. If you are working the chart, work all rounds from right to left.

Horseshoe Lace (Multiple of 10 sts) <u>Rnd 1:</u> \*K1, yo, k3, sl 1-k2tog-psso, k3, yo; rep from \* across. <u>Rnd 2:</u> K across. <u>Rnd 3:</u> \*P1, k1, yo, k2, sl 1-k2tog-psso, k2, yo, k1; rep from \* across. <u>Rnd 4:</u> \*P1, k9; rep from \* across. <u>Rnd 5:</u> \*P1, k2, yo, k1, sl 1-k2tog-psso, k1, yo, k2; rep from \* across. <u>Rnd 6:</u> Same as rnd 4. <u>Rnd 7:</u> \*P1, k3, yo, sl 1-k2tog-psso, yo, k3; rep from \* across.

Horseshoe Lace Decrease Chart <u>Rnd 1:</u> \*p1, k9; rep from \* across. <u>Rnd 2</u>: move m 1 st to the right, \*P3tog, k1, yo, k1, sl 1-k2tog-psso, k1, yo, k1; rep from \* across. <u>Rnd 3</u>: \*P1, k7; rep from \* across. <u>Rnd 4</u>: move m 1 st to the right, \*P3tog, k1, yo, sl 1-k2tog-psso, yo, k1; rep from \* across. <u>Rnd 5</u>: \*P1, k5; rep from \* across. <u>Rnd 6</u>: move m 1 st to the right, \*P3tog, yo, sl 1-k2tog-psso, yo; rep from \* across. <u>Rnd 7</u>: \*P1, k3; rep from \* across.

### Begin

With smaller circular, CO 130 sts. Join in the rnd, being careful not to twists. PM. <u>Rib Rnd:</u> \*K1, p1; rep from \* across. Rep this rnd for  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), CO= cast on, cont= continue, DPNs=double pointed needles, inc- increase, k- knit, kf&b= knit into the front and back of stitch, k2tog= knit two sts together, m1=make one, m= marker, mm= millimeter, PM/pm= place marker, p= purl, p3tog= purl three sts together, psso= pass slipped stitch over, rep= repeat, rnd=round, sl= slip, ssk = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, sl= slip, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tog = together, yo= yarn over

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<u>Inc Rnd:</u> \*K13, m1; rep from \* across. 140 sts on needle. Switch to larger circular needle. Work <u>Horseshoe Lace</u> rnds 1-8 five times, then work rnds 1-3 once more.

Work <u>Horseshoe Lace Decrease</u> rnds 1-7, moving the m over 1 st to the right on rnds 2, 4 and 6. Switch to DPNs when there are too few sts to fit comfortably on the circular. 56 sts on needle.

<u>Next Rnd:</u> move the m over 1 st to the right, \*P3tog, k1; rep from \* across. 28 sts on needle.

Next Rnd: K2tog across. 14 sts on needle.


Next Rnd: K2tog across. 7 sts on needle.

Next Rnd: K1, \*k2tog; rep from \* across.

4 sts on needle. Cut yarn, leaving a 4" tail. Thread tapestry needle and gather remaining sts. Pull tight and fasten off. Weave in all ends and block to measurements.

Use a circular dinner plate to block the damp hat to create a beret-look. Let it air dry before removing.
