

### DRIFTONE Drop Stitch Cowl



#### Approximate Measurements

*After blocking*

**6" long (excluding fringe) x  
35" circumference**

#### Materials:

##### Driftone:

**2—50g balls, color 08 Red Tone**

**Gauge:** 24 sts, 48 rows= 4" in garter st  
on US Size 5 (3.75mm) *after blocking*.

20.5 sts = 4" after Drop Stitch Rnd on  
US Size 5 (3.75mm) *after blocking*.

**Needles:** US Size 5 (3.75mm) – 24" circular,  
1 st marker (m).

#### Garter Stitch

Rnd 1: K all sts.

Rnd 2: P all sts

Rep these 2 rnds for pattern stitch.

#### 2x2 Rib

Rnd 1: \*K2, p2; rep from \* across.

Rep this rnd for pattern stitch.

**NOTE:** DO NOT use a crochet cast on.

#### **Begin**

CO 180 sts. Join in the rnd, being  
careful not to twist sts. PM. Work in  
Garter Stitch for 64 rnds.

Drop Stitch Rnd: \*K5, sl the next st on  
the left hand needle off the needle and  
unravel it a couple rows. Pick up the  
top-most bar between the sts with the

left hand needle, k this st (Note: no sts were dec'd); rep from \* across.  
180 sts on needle.

Work in 2x2 Rib for ½". BO all sts in rib on next rnd.

#### Finishing

Gently unravel the dropped sts all the way down to the CO edge.

Fringe: Cut 60- 11" long strands and attach 2 strands to the bottom 3 strands at each dropped stitch section along the  
CO edge. Trim the fringe, if necessary. Weave in all ends and wet block.

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
