

**Fantasy Naturale  
Small Market Bag**



**Size:** About 12” long- unstuffed. Bag grows much larger when stuffed

**Gauge:** 18 st = 4” over garter st on size 7 needles

**Materials:** 2 -100g hanks Fantasy Naturale- shown in color 9966

**Needles:** 16” circular size 7(4.5mm) & 10.5(6.5mm); Stitch marker

**Cords—Make first and set aside**

Make 2 long twisted cords as follows:

Cut 2—5 yard strands. Fold in half and tie onto a door knob. Starting at the folded ends, create a twisted cord. Finished length of cord will be about 36” once cord is allowed to twist up on itself. Make a second cord the same using another 2—5 yard long strands. Set aside.

Cords can be made much longer if you wish- there is plenty of yarn. Try 7 yards for each strand for shoulder length cords.

**Bottom**

Loosely cast on 22 sts on smaller circular needle.

Work 20 rows in garter stitch. Pick up and knit 20 sts along side edge, 22 sts along cast on edge and 20 sts along 4<sup>th</sup> side edge: 84 sts. Place a marker to indicate beginning of the round and join.

**Sides**

Knit 3 rounds

Change to larger needles and knit 1 round.

Begin pattern:

Round 1: \* (K2tog, YO); repeat from \* around.

Round 2: Knit around.

Round 3: \* (K1, YO); repeat from \* around.

Round 4: \* (K2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 5: \* (K2tog, YO); repeat from \* around.

Round 6: Knit around.

Repeat rounds 1-6 – about 7 more times, or until almost out of yarn, allowing enough for 6 more rounds and the bind off.

Change to smaller needles, and knit 3 rounds.

Next round: \* (K2tog, YO); repeat from \* around.

Knit 2 rounds.

Bind off loosely. Weave in all ends.

Weave 1 piece of twisted cord through holes in top clockwise. Tie ends together.

Starting at the opposite side, weave second piece of cord through holes counterclockwise. Tie ends together. You can cut ends to fringe them if desired.

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
