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MUSHISHI BIG Umbrella Stitch Boot Toppers



To Fit Women's Medium Approximate Measurements *after blocking* **12" tall x 10" circumference at widest point** *unstretched*

Materials: Mushishi Big: 2—100G skeins, color 101 grey Gauge: 14.5 sts, 19 rows= 4" in Umbrella Stitch on US Size 10 (6mm) *after blocking*, 14.5 sts, 20 rows= 4" in <u>2x2 Rib</u> on US Size 10 (6mm) *slight stretched*. Needles: US Size 10 (6mm) DPNs, 1 st marker (m).

Work all chart rounds from right to left.

2x2 Rib Rnd 1: *K2, p2; rep from * across. Rep this rnd for pattern stitch.

Begin

(Make 2) <u>Cuff</u> Long-tail CO 36 sts, divide onto 3 DPNs. Join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. PM. Work Umbrella Stitch Rnds 1-13 twice. <u>Dec Rnd:</u> *K2tog, p2, (k2, p2)3 times, k2tog; rep from * once more. 32 sts on needles.

Leg

Work in 2x2 rib for 5 rnds. <u>Dec Rnd 1:</u> K1, p2tog, rib to last 3 sts, p2tog, k1—2 sts dec'd.

30 sts on needles.

Work in established rib until piece measures 12" from CO edge. BO all sts in rib using your favorite stretchy BO method. Weave in all ends.


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ABBREVIATIONS: BO= bind off, CO= cast on, dec = decrease, DPNs- double pointed needles, k= knit, k2tog= knit two sts together, m= marker, m1= make one, mm= millimeter, PM= place marker, p = purl, p2tog= purl two sts together, rep= repeat, RS= right side, rnd- round, sl = slip, SSK = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tog = together, yo= yarn over

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
