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MUSHISHI BIG Drop Stitch Cowl



BO all sts in rib on next rnd.

Approximate Measurements: 9" length x 33 ½" circumference

Materials:

Mushishi Big:

3—100G skeins, color 101 grey **Gauge:** 12 sts, 24 rows= 4" in Garter Stitch on US Size 10 (6mm) after

blocking.

Needles: US Size 10 (6mm) – 24" circular,

1 st marker (m).

Garter Stitch

Rnd 1: K all sts. Rnd 2: P all sts

Rep these 2 rnds for pattern stitch.

Rnd 1: *K2, p2; rep from * across. Rep this rnd for pattern stitch.

Begin

CO 100 sts. Join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. PM. Work in Garter Stitch for 8", end having worked a p rnd.

Next Rnd: *K3, sl the next st on the left hand needle off the needle and unravel it a couple rows, pick up the top-most bar between the sts with the left hand needle and k this st (Note: no sts were dec'd); rep from * across.

Work in 2x2 Rib for 1".

Gently unravel the dropped sts all the way down to the CO edge.

Fringe: Cut 50-11" long strands and attach 2 strands to the bottom 3 strands at each dropped stitch section along the CO edge. Weave in all ends.
