YARNIMAL Scarf Kit Matching Hat & Mittens



Size: 16" (18") -- 4-6 years (8-10 years).

Materials: 1- Yarnimal Scarf Kit- shown in

Monkey color 811

Needles: 16" circular size US 7 (4.5mm) plus dpns size US 7(4.5mm); 1 stitch

marker.

Gauge: 20 sts and 24 rows = 4" over st st.

<u>K1/p1 ribbing:</u> *(K1, p1); repeat from * around. Repeat this round every round for ribbing.

Loosely cast on 80 (90) sts. Place marker and join into the round. Work in the round in k1/p1 ribbing for 1.5 (2)", ending at the marker.

Change to st st and work until total length is 6.5 (7.5)", ending at the marker.

Begin decreasing, changing to double points when needed.

Rd 1: *(K8, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Rd 2: Knit

Rd 3: *(K7, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Rd 2: Knit.

Rd 4: *(K6, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Rd 5: Knit.

Rd 6: *(K5, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Rd 7: *(K4, k2tog); repeat from * around. Rd 8: *(K3, k2tog); repeat from * around. Rd 9: *(K2, k2tog); repeat from * around. Rd 10: *(K1, k2tog); repeat from * around. Rd 11: *(K2tog); repeat from * around.

Cut yarn and thread through remaining sts. Pull up tight and anchor. Weave in all ends.

Placing of adornments:

Place top of adornment head about an inch below top of hat- tack down all around head. Place 2 front legs in front on sides of head so that they- hang no lower than bottom edge of hat. Tack down tops of legs only. Place 2 back legs lower than front legs, tail in the middle. Back adornments can hang below bottom edge of hat if desired. Tack down tops of legs and tail only. Weave in all ends.

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Matching Mittens:

Sizes: 4-6 years (8-10 years). **Materials:** Yarnimal Scarf Kit.

Needles: 1 set of dpns- Size US 7(4.5mm).

small st holder, st markers.

Gauge: 20 sts & 24 rows = 4" over st st.

Cast on 28 (32) sts.

Divide sts onto 3 needles. Join in the round.

Work in k1/p1 ribbing for 2 (3)".

Next row: Knit around, increasing 2 (4) sts evenly spaced for a total of 30 (36) sts.

Knit 3 (4) rounds even.

Make thumb gusset:

Round 1: K3, place marker, m1, K2, m1, place marker, knit around (4 sts between markers).

Round 2: Knit around.

Repeat rounds 1 and 2, increasing one st after the first st marker and one st before the second st marker on every odd-numbered

round until you have 10 (12) sts between markers.

Knit one round even after last increase round.

Remove thumb sts as follows: K3, place next 10 (12) sts (sts between markers) on a holder, cast on 2 sts, continue knitting around. You now have 30 (36) sts on your needles.

Knit 16 (20) rounds even.

Shape top of mittens:

Round 1: *(K4, K2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 2: Knit.

Round 3: *(K3, K2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 4: Knit.

Round 5: *(K2, K2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 6: Knit.

Round 7: *(K1, K2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 8: *(K2tog); repeat from * around.

Cut yarn, thread yarn through remaining 5 (6) stitches and pull up tight and anchor.

Thumb: Pick up 10 (12) sts from holder. Pick up 4 sts from the thumb opening -- the 2 you cast on plus one from either side. 14 (16) sts now on needles. Divide onto 3 needles.

Knit 1 round, decreasing 2 sts by working k2tog twice at base of thumb: 12 (14) thumb sts.

Knit around on 12 (14) sts for 10 (12) rounds.

K2tog all the way around (6) (7) sts. Cut yarn leaving a 10-inch end.

Draw through 6 (7) remaining stitches and pull tight and anchor. Weave on all ends. Make second mitten to match.

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ABBREVIATIONS: K = knit, p = purl, st(s) = stitch(es), pm = place marker, k2tog = knit 2 sts together, st st = stockinette stitch, make 1 = Place bar that runs between last st and next st onto needle, kniti nto the back ofit.

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
