

## GINA Pond Lily Pillow



**Size:** 12" wide 16" long

**Materials:** 3 – 50g balls Gina, color 11

**Needles:** US 9(5.5mm), crochet hook size H(5.00 mm)

**Gauge:** 16 sts= 4" over pattern

**Optional:** 1 decorative embellishment; 1 --12" X 16" pillow form; 1/2 yard fabric to cover pillow form

Cast on 66 sts. and work in following pattern stitch for 4 repeats, for flap of pillow working first three and last three stitches in garter stitch throughout pillow length.

Row 1: ( K1, yo, K1, skp, K 2 tog, K1, yo, K3, p1), repeat ( to ) across row, beginning and ending row with knit 3.

Row 2 and all even numbered rows: Purl

Row 3: \*(K2, yo, K1, skp, K2 tog, K1, yo, K2, P1); repeat from \* across row.

Row 5: \*(K3, yo, K1, skp, K2 tog, K1, yo, K1, P1); repeat from \* across row.

Row 7: \*(K2, yo, K1, skp, K2 tog, K1, yo, K2, P1); repeat from \* across row.

Row 8: Purl.

Rows 1- 8 = 1 pattern repeat of pattern stitch

Knit 2 rows, Purl 1 row, Knit 1 row (flap should measure 6" ).

Continue working in stockinette stitch for an additional 27.25". Purl 1 row. Knit 1 row.

Bind off loosely.



Decorative flap edging: Using size H crochet hook work as follows:

Row 1: Work 1 sc in each st across flap, ch 1, turn.

Row 2: Work 1 sc in next 5 scs, \* work 3 dc in next sc, work 1 sc in next 10 sc ; repeat from \* ending row by working 1 sc in next 10 sc, ch 1, do not turn, work 1 row of reverse sc along flap edge. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Finishing:

Wrap knitted piece over covered pillow form placing flap approximately 2/3 of the length of pillow. Work 1 row of sc and 1 row of rev sc along edge, turning work so that rev sc matches flap edging. Tack flap.

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
