

GALWAY ROVING
Ribbed Hat



To Fit Adult- 19 ¼” circumference

Materials:

Galway Roving

1—100g ball EACH,

color 28 Delft and 185 Indigo

(Please note- almost all of the Indigo was used in our hat. If you want to be cautious, purchase 2 balls instead of one.)

Gauge: 10 sts, 12 rows = 4” in **1x1 rib** on size US 15 (10mm) needle *slightly stretched*,

Needles/Notions: US Size 15 (10mm) 24” circular, 1 st marker (m), US Size 11, 13 **or** 15 DPNs

1x1 rib

Rnd 1: *K1, p1; rep from * across.

Rep this rnd for pattern st.

Begin

Brim

With circular needle and Indigo, CO 48 sts.

Join in the rnd and pm.

Work in **1x1 rib** for 15 rnds.

Body

Work in **1x1 rib** for 2 rnds in Delft.

Work in **1x1 rib** for 1 rnd in Indigo.

The above 3 rnds establish the stripe pattern.

Cont to work in stripe pattern now and throughout.

(It is not necessary to cut the non-working yarn. Instead, carry it up the inside of the hat loosely until you are ready to use it again.)

When 10 total rnds of the body have been worked, beg crown shaping on next rnd.

Crown Shaping

(Switch to DPNs when there aren't enough sts to fit comfortably on the circular.)

Rnd 1: *Rib 6, k2tog; rep from * across.

Rnd 2: K the k and p the p sts.

Rnd 3: *Rib 5, k2tog; rep from * across.

Rnd 4: *Rib 4, k2tog; rep from * across.

Rnd 5: *Rib 3, k2tog; rep from * across.

Rnd 6: *Rib 2, k2tog; rep from * across.

Rnd 7: *Rib 1, k2tog; rep from * across.

Rnd 8: *K2tog; rep from * across.

Cut yarn, draw through rem sts.

Fasten off. Weave in all ends.

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
