## CANNOLI AND ENCORE MEGA Brioche Cowl



**Approximate Measurements: 32**" circumference x 9" width

#### Materials: Cannoli: 1—100G ball, color Purple/Green/Blue Encore Mega: 1—100G balls, color 273 Teal Gauge: 6 sts, 18 rows= 4" in <u>Brioche</u> <u>Stitch</u> on US Size 15 (10mm) knitting needle. Needles/Notions: US Size 15 (10mm) – 24" circular needle, 1 st marker (m).

When working Brioche, each knit stitch that you see counts as 2 rows.

#### Begin

With Encore Mega, long-tail CO 48 sts. Join in the rnd and pm, being careful not to twist sts. K 1 rnd. Drop Encore Mega, leaving it to the back of work. Join Cannoli.

<u>Rnd 1:</u> With Cannoli, **\*sl 1 yo** (**sl 1 yo=** lay the yarn under the needle to the front of the work, sl the next st purlwise, then lay the yarn back over the top of the needle and over the sl st to the back), p1; rep from \* around. Drop Cannoli, leaving it to the back of work.

<u>Rnd 2:</u> With Encore Mega, \*k2tog (knit together the slipped stitch with its yarn over), **sl 1 yo**; rep from \* around. Drop Encore Mega, leaving it to the back of work.

<u>Rnd 3:</u> With Cannoli, \*sl 1 yo, p2tog, (purl together the slipped stitch with its yarn over); rep from \* around. Drop Cannoli, leaving it to the back of work.

<u>Rnd 4:</u> With Encore Mega, \*k2tog (knit together the slipped stitch with its yarn over), **sl 1 yo**; rep from \* around. Drop Encore Mega, leaving it to the back of work.

Rep Rnds 3 and 4 until you are almost out of Encore Mega, end having worked Rnd 3; you'll want to leave enough yarn to work 2 more rounds with Encore Mega. Cut Cannoli, leaving a 6" tail for weaving in.

Next Rnd: With Encore Mega, \*K2tog, p1; rep from \* around. BO all sts in knit on next rnd. Weave in all ends.

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ABBREVIATIONS: BO= bind off, CO= cast on, cont= continue, dec = decrease, inc = increase, k = knit, k2tog= knit two stitches together, m=marker, p = purl, pm= place marker, rep= repeat, Rnd/rnd= round, SI= slip, ssk = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es)
