

### ENCORE MEGA COLORSPUN Cabled Hat



To Fit Average Adult- 20”  
circumference *unstretched*

#### **Materials:**

**Encore Mega Colorspun:**

**1—100g ball, color 7164 Blue/Denim**

**Gauge:** 8 sts, 12 rows = 4” in st st on US  
Size 15 (10mm) *after blocking.*

**Needles:** US Size 15 (10mm)- 16” circular and  
DPNs, 1 st marker (m), 1 cable needle.

#### **Begin**

With circular needle, CO 40 sts. Join in  
the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. PM.

**Rib Rnd:** \*P2, k2; rep from \* around. Rep  
this rnd 4 times more.

**Cable Pattern** (worked over 10 sts)

**Rnd 1:** P2, C4F, k2, p2.

**Rnd 2:** P2, k6, p2.

**Rnd 3:** P2, k2, C4B, p2.

**Rnd 4:** Same as rnd 2.

Rep these 4 rnds for pattern st.

#### **Pattern Setup**

**Rnd 1:** K15, work **Cable Pattern**, k15.

Rep the last rnd until 16 total rnds of  
**Cable pattern** have been worked.

#### **Decrease for Crown**

(Switch to DPNs when there aren't enough sts to fit comfortably around the circular needle)

**Rnd 1:** Ssk, k3, k2tog, ssk, k3, k2tog, k1, work **Cable Pattern rnd 1**, k1, ssk, k3, k2tog, ssk, k3, k2tog—8 sts dec'd.  
32 sts on needle.

**Rnd 2:** K11, work **Cable Pattern rnd 2**, k11.

**Rnd 3:** Ssk, k1, k2tog, ssk, k1, k2tog, k1, work **Cable Pattern rnd 3**, k1, ssk, k1, k2tog, ssk, k1, k2tog—8 sts dec'd.  
24 sts on needle.

**Rnd 4:** K7, p2tog, k6, p2tog, k7—2 sts dec'd. 22 sts on needle.

**Rnd 5:** (Sl 1-k2tog-*pss*o)twice, k1, p1, sl 2 sts to cable needle and hold to front, k2tog, k2 from cable needle, k2, p1,  
k1, (sl 1-k2tog-*pss*o)twice—9 sts dec'd. 13 sts on needle.

**Rnd 6:** K3, p1, k5, p1, k3.

**Rnd 7:** Sl 1-k2tog-*pss*o, p1, k1, sl 2 sts to cable needle and hold to back, k2, k2tog from cable needle, p1, sl 1-k2tog-*pss*o—5 sts dec'd. 8 sts rem. Cut yarn, draw through rem sts. Pull tightly and fasten off. Weave in all ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: C4B= sl 2 sts to cable needle and hold to back, k2, k2 from cable needle, C4F= sl 2 sts to cable needle and hold to front, k2, k2 from cable needle, CO= cast on, dec= decrease, DPNs= double pointed needles, inc= increase, k = knit, k2tog= knit two sts together, kf&b= knit into the front and back of next st, mm= millimeter, p= purl, rem= remain(ing), Rep/rep= repeat(ing), Rnd/rnd= round, sl = slip, ssk = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tog = together
