MUSHISHI Crochet Pocket Scarf



Approximate Measurements: after blocking 7" wide x 57" long

Materials: Mushishi: 1—250g skein, color 16 Emerald Gauge: 14 DCs = 4" on US Size H (5mm) crochet hook *after blocking*. Needles: US Size H (5mm) crochet hook.

Special Stitches:

DCFP (Double Crochet into the front post): YO and insert your hook from front to back before the post of the st in the row below, then from back to front on the other side of the post. Work a DC.

DCBP (Double Crochet into the back post): YO and insert your hook from back to front before the post of the st in the row below, then from front to back on the other side of the post. Work a DC.

2 DC Cluster: (YO, insert hook in the next space, YO and pull up a st, YO and go through 2 loops on hook) twice. YO and go through 3 loops on the hook.

Except when noted, work into both loops of the st in the row below.

Scarf

CH 27. YO and Insert hook into 4th CH from hook. DC in this CH and in each CH to the end. (25 DCs)

<u>Row 1 (WS)</u>: CH 3 (counts as a DC here and throughout the pattern), sk the 1st DC, DC to the last st which will be in the turning CH. Turn.

Row 2 (RS): Repeat Row 1.

<u>Row 3:</u> DC across the row, working in the back loop only. Turn.

<u>Row 4:</u> CH 3, sk 1st DC, DC in each of the next 7 sts, CH 3, sk next DC, SC in next DC, CH 3, sk next DC, DC in next 3 DCs, CH 3, sk next DC, SC in next DC, CH 3, sk next DC, DC in last 8 sts. Turn.

Row 5: CH 3, sk 1st DC, 5 DCs, DCBP in next st, 1 DC, CH 1, 2 DC Clusters worked across next 2 CH-3 loops, CH 1, 3 DCs, CH 1, 2 DC Clusters in next CH 3 loops, CH 1, 1 DC, DCBP in next st, 6 DCs to end. Turn.

<u>Row 6:</u> CH 3, sk 1st DC, 5 DCs, DCFP in next st, 1 DC, CH 3, sk next CH 1 SP, SC in next cluster, CH 3, sk CH 1 SP, 3 DCs, CH 3, sk 1 CH 1 SP, SC in next cluster, CH 3, sk 1 CH 1 SP, 1 DC, DCFP, 6 DCs to end. Turn. Rep Rows 5 and 6 until you have worked 5" from Row 3 and have completed a RS row. Work 1 row of DCs. Fasten off. This is the pocket at the bottom of the scarf.

With the WS facing, locate the loops that were unworked on Row 3. Insert the hook into the first loop on the right. CH 3 and DC in each loop across the row. Turn.

Row 4: Rep Row 4 of the pocket.

Row 5: Rep Row 5 of the pocket

Row 6: Rep Row 6 of the pocket.

Rep Rows 5 and 6 until the scarf measures $28 \frac{1}{2}$ ". Fasten off. Sew the pocket flap to the sides of the scarf. Fold up the first DC row at the beg of each sections and stitch across to form a hem. Make another section in the same manner and sew the 2 parts together at the neck.
