# PLYMOUTH YARN®

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### MERINO TEXTURA Fingerless Mitts



Approximate Measurements after blocking 6 ½" wide x 7 ½" long

Materials:

Merino Textura: 1—100g skein, color 7 Merlot Shadow Gauge: 18 sts, 28 rows = 4" in st st and Lacy Arrow on US Size 7 (4.5mm) needle *after blocking*. Needles/Notions: US Size 7 (4.5mm) DPNs, 5 st marker (m)- 1 in a one color, 2 in a second color, and 2 in a third color, scrap yarn.

You can make 2 pairs (4 mitts) with one skein.

Follow either the written or charted directions for the <u>Lacy Arrow</u> stitch. If you are following the chart directions, work all rounds from right to left.

<u>Rib Rnd:</u> \*K1, p1; rep from \* around. Rep this rnd for pattern st.

Lacy Arrow (Worked over 9 sts) <u>Rnd 1 (RS):</u> P1, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, p1. <u>Rnds 2 and 4:</u> P1, k7, p1. <u>Rnd 3:</u> P1, k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, p1. <u>Rnd 5:</u> P1, k2, yo, sl 1-k2tog-psso, yo, k2, p1.

<u>Rnd 6:</u> Same as row 2. Rep these 6 rnds for pattern st.

#### Begin

CO 30 sts- distributing the sts evenly on DPNs. Join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. PM that is a different color than the rest. Work <u>Rib Rnd</u> for 4 rnds, inc 1 st on last rnd. 31 sts on needle.

Rnd 1: K11, pm, work next 9 sts in Lacy Arrow, pm, k11.

Rnd 2: K to m, sl m, work next row in Lacy Arrow to m, sl m, k to end.

Cont as established, work progressing in Lacy Arrow st until you have worked 30 rnds (5 total rep) of the lace st.

**Abbreviations:** beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CO= cast on, dec= decrease, DPNs= double pointed needles, inc= increase, k = knit, k2tog = knit two together, m= marker, pm= place marker, psso= pass slipped stitch over, rem= remaining, rep= repeat, rnd= round, RS= right side, sl = slip, ssk =slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st =stockinette st, WS= wrong side, yo= yarn over

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<u>Right Mitt</u> (You will now use the third color markers to mark thumb sts) <u>Rnd 1:</u> Pattern across 23 sts, pm, m1, k1, m1, pm, pattern to end of rnd—2 sts inc'd. 33 sts on needles- 3 sts in between the third color m. <u>Rnd 2:</u> Pattern across all sts- working in st st on the thumb sts. <u>Rnd 3:</u> Pattern across to third color m, sl m, m1, k to m, m1, sl m, pattern to end of rnd—2 sts inc'd. Rep rnds 2 and 3 three times more. 43 sts on needles- 11 sts in between the third color m. <u>Next Rnd:</u> Pattern across to third color m, remove third color m, sl the next 11 sts onto scrap yarn, remove third color m, CO 1 st onto the left hand needle, pattern across to end of rnd. 31 sts on needle. <u>Left Mitt</u> (You will now use the third color markers to mark thumb sts.)

<u>Rnd 1:</u> Pattern across 7 sts, pm, m1, k1, m1, pm, pattern to end of rnd—2 sts inc'd.

33 sts on needles—3 sts in between the third color m.

Rnd 2: Pattern across all sts- working in st st on the thumb sts.

Rnd 3: Pattern across to third color m, sl m, m1, k to m, m1, sl m, pattern to end of rnd-2 sts inc'd.

Rep rnds 2 and 3 three times more. 43 sts on needles- 11 sts in between the third color m.

<u>Next Rnd:</u> Pattern across to third color m, remove third color m, sl the next 11 sts onto scrap yarn, remove third color m, CO 1 st onto the left hand needle, pattern across to end of rnd. 31 sts on needle.


### Both Mitts

Work 8 more rnds, dec 1 st across last rnd. 30 sts on needle. Work Rib Rnd for 4 rnds. BO all sts on next rnd in rib.

### <u>Thumb</u>

With RS facing, unzip the scrap yarn from the 11 sts on the thumb. Distribute the sts onto 3 DPNs. Pick up 1 st from the CO edge of the thumb. 12 st on needle. Join in the rnd and pm. Work <u>Rib Rnd</u> for 2 rnds. BO all sts in rib on next rnd. Rep for the other thumb. Weave in all ends.

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
