LINAZA HAND DYED Mock Rib Cowl



Finished Measurements *after blocking*
10" wide x 40" circumference

Materials

Linaza Hand Dyed: 1—100g skein, color 04
Mauve/Pink/Orange

Gauge: 14 sts and 28 rows = 4" in Mock Rib *after blocking*

Needles/Notions: US size 9 (5.5mm) 24" circular
needle, 1 st marker (m)

When working the Mock Rib gauge swatch, each
knit stitch that you see counts as 2 rows.

Special Abbreviation

sl 1 yo = lay the yarn under the needle to the front of
the work, sl the next st purlwise, then lay the yarn
back over the top of the needle and over the sl st to
the back.



Mock Rib worked flat (Multiple of 4 sts + 2)

Setup Row (RS): P2, *p2, (**sl 1 yo**) twice, rep from * to last 2
sts, p2.

Row 1 (WS): K2, *(**sl 1 yo**) twice, (k2tog) twice; rep from * to
last 4 sts, (**sl 1 yo**) twice, k2

Row 2: P2, (p2tog) twice, *(**sl 1 yo**) twice, (p2tog) twice; rep
from * to last 2 sts, p2.

Rep rows 1 and 2 for pattern st.

Begin

With Orange Shadow, CO 34 sts. Work Mock Rib worked flat for 40", end having worked row 2.

Next Row (WS): K2, *k2, (k2tog) twice; Rep from * to last 2 sts, k4. BO all sts on next row in p.

Finishing

Sew the CO and BO edges together to form a loop. Weave in loose ends. Block to finished measurements.

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Abbreviations: CO: cast on, K: knit, K2tog: Knit two stitches together, m: marker, mm: millimeter, P: purl, PM: place marker, Rep: repeat, RS: right side, St(s): stitch(es), WS: Wrong Side, YO: yarn over
