### MERINO TEXTURA Ribbed Hat



Rnd 1: \*Ssk, rib to 2 sts before next m, k2tog, sl m; rep from \* around—10 sts dec'd. 85 sts on needle. Rep the last rnd 7 times more—70 sts dec'd. 15 sts on needle. Cut yarn, draw through rem sts. Fasten off. Weave in all ends.

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To Fit Average Adult- approximately 21 ½" circumference, *stretched*.

#### Materials:

Merino Textura: 1—100g skein, color 10 Blue Shadow Gauge: 18 sts, 28 rows = 4" in 2x1 rib on US Size 5 (3.75mm) needle *slightly stretched*. Needles/Notions: US Size 5 (3.75mm) 16" circular and DPNs, 5 st marker (m), 1 in a different color than the rest

#### Begin

With circular CO 96 sts. Join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. PM in the different color than the rest to mark beg of rnd.

<u>Rib Rnd:</u> \*K2, p1; rep from \* around. Rep the rib rnd for 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ , dec 1 st across last rnd. 95 sts on needle.

Shape Crown

(Switch to DPNs when there aren't enough sts to fit comfortably on the circular needle.) Place a m after every 19<sup>th</sup> st.



**Abbreviations:** beg= begin(ning), CO= cast on, dec= decrease, DPNs= double pointed needles, inc= increase, k = knit, k2tog = knit two together, m= marker, mm= millimeter, pm= place marker, rem= remaining, Rep= repeat, Rnd/rnd= round, RS= right side, Ssk =slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st
