Ribbed Poncho



ABBREVIATIONS: b beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CO= cast on, k = knit, mm= millimeter, p= purl, rep= repeat, RS= right side, st(s) = stitch(es), st st =stockinette st, WS= wrong side

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To Fit Average Adult

Materials:

Cashmere de Cotone: 3—50G balls, color 09 Rose, 2—50G balls, color 08 Grey

Gauge: 15 sts, 24 rows = 4" in st st on US Size 10 (6mm) needle *after blocking*.

Needles/Notions: US Size 10 (6mm)- 24" circular, tapestry needle.

Rib Stitch

(Worked over a multiple of 4 sts + 3)

Row 1 (RS): *K3, p1; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 2 (WS): P across.

Rep these 2 rows for pattern stitch.


Begin

With Rose, CO 83 sts. Work in Rib Stitch for 32", end having worked a WS Row. Cut Rose and attached Grey. Work 16" more in pattern stitch. BO all sts on next row.

Finishing

Refer to diagram—seam the sections marked "A" together. Weave in all ends.
