ENCORE WORSTED Baseball Scarves



Approximate Finished Measurements:

7" x 72" for Half Striped Scarf, 7" x 59" for Baseball Pocket Scarf

Materials:

Encore Worsted:

1—100g ball EACH of 2 team colors ** We used 9601 (MC) and 208 (CC) for half striped scarf 217 (MC) and 460 (CC) for all baseball pocket scarf version

- plus 1 ball of 208 and 1386 if you are making the baseball pockets

Gauge: 20 sts= 4" in 1x1 ribbing on US size 7 (4.5mm) needles slightly stretched.

Needles: Size US 7 (4.5mm) straight knitting needle, tapestry needle.

For Baseball: US Size 7 (4.5mm) 16" circular and DPNs, 6 st markers- 5 in one color and 1 in another.

ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CC= contrast color, CO= cast on, dec= decrease, DPNs= double pointed needle, inc= increase, k = knit, k2tog= knit two stitches together, kf&b= knit into the front and back of next stitch, m= marker, MC= main color, mm= millimeter, p= purl, pm= place marker, rep= repeat, rnd= round, ssk = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st= stitch, WS= wrong side

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1x1 Rib

Row 1: *K1, p1; rep from * across. Rep this row for pattern st.

Half Striped Scarf

With MC, CO 36 sts. Work in 1x1 Rib for 37".

(1" in CC, 1" in MC)17 times. Work 1" more with CC. BO all sts in rib on next row. Weave in all ends.

Baseball Pocket Scarf

With MC, CO 36 sts. Work in <u>1x1 Rib</u> now and throughout stripe sequence as follows: (1" in MC, 1" in CC)29 times. Work 1" more with MC. BO all sts in rib on next row. Weave in all ends.

Baseball

With color 208 (white) and circular needle, CO 54 sts. K 1 row, do not turn. Join in the rnd and pm that is a different color than the rest.

Setup Rnd: (k9, pm)6 times.

Dec Rnd: (Ssk, k to m, sl m)6 times—6 sts dec'd.

48 sts on needle. Rep the <u>Dec Rnd</u> every other rnd 7 times more—switch to DPNs when there aren't enough sts to fit comfortably on the circular.

6 sts on needle. Cut yarn, leaving a 4" tail, thread tapestry needle. Thread the tail through the remaining sts. Fasten off securely. With tapestry needle and color 1386 (red) held double stitch two rows of "v" stitches to mimic the stitches on a baseball. Make another identical baseball pocket. Stitch each ball to the ends of the scarf—leaving the top part unsewn for a pocket-opening. Weave in all ends.

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
