HOMESTEAD Fairisle Cowl



Approximate Finished Dimensions 10 1/2" wide x 31" circumference after blocking

Materials:

Homestead:

2—100g skeins, color 2 Taupe Heather MC

1—100g skein, color 6 Oatmeal Heather CC

Gauge: 18 sts= 4" in st st on US Size 7 (4.5mm) needle after blocking.

Needles/Notions: US Size 7 (4.5mm) 16" or 24" circular plus a spare circular in a similar size, 1 st marker, scrap yarn, US Size G (4.5mm) crochet hook

ABBREVIATIONS: BO= bind off, CC= contract color, CO= cast on, inc= increase, K=knit, k2tog=knit two together, m= marker, MC= main color, mm= millimeter, P=purl, PM=place marker, Rep=repeat, RS=right side, sl= slip one purlwise with yarn in front, st(s)=stitch(es), w&t= wrap and turn, WS=wrong side, YO= yarn over



Work the chart rounds from right to left.

Long "floats" of yarn can occur in some rounds—if you have a succession of 6 sts or more of a single color, it is a good idea to twist the two colors together so that the floats aren't too long.

Begin

With scrap yarn and crochet hook, work a provisional crochet chain of 96 sts. Cut scrap yarn and pick up and k 96

sts along the crochet chain. Join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. PM. Work Arrow Fairisle Chart Rnds 1-10 fourteen times. Unravel the scrap yarn chain and place the stitches onto the spare circular. Kitchener stitch the last round worked with the beg of the cowl. Weave in all ends. Block as necessary.
