

PLYMOUTH YARN®

JEANNEE Lace Stole



Approximate Finished Measurements 17 ½” wide x 66” long *after blocking*

Materials:

Jeannee Worsted: 8—50G balls, color 26 Salmon

Gauge: 18 sts, 24 rows = 4” on US size 7 (4.5mm) needle in Diamond Lace Stitch *after blocking*.

Needles/Notions: US Size 7 (4.5mm) long straight knitting needles, 1 stitch holder, tapestry needle.

ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CO= cast on, k = knit, k2tog = knit two together, m= marker, mm= millimeter, p= purl, p2tog= purl two stitches together, p3tog= purl three stitches together, rep= repeat, RS= right side, sl = slip, ssk =slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st =stockinette st, WS= wrong side, yo= yarn over

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The stole is worked in two pieces and joined together at the center using Kitchener stitch.

Garter stitch= k every row.

A note about the chart: Only Right Side Rows are shown. All Wrong Side Rows are worked as follows:
WS Rows: K1, *p6, k1; rep from * across.

Diamond Lace Stitch

(Multiple of 14 sts + 15)

Row 1 (RS): P1, k2, k2tog, k2, yo, *p1, yo, k2, ssk, k2, p1, k2, k2tog, k2, yo; rep from * to last 8 sts, p1, yo, k2, ssk, k2, p1.

Row 2 and all WS Rows: K1, *p6, k1; rep from * across.

Row 3: P1, k1, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, *p1, k1, yo, k2, ssk, k1, p, k1, k2tog, k2, yo, k1; rep from * to last 8 sts, p1, k1, yo, k2, ssk, k1, p1.

Row 5: P1, k2tog, k2, yo, k2, *p, k2, yo, k2, ssk, p1, k2tog, k2, yo, k2; rep from * to last 8 sts, p1, k2, yo, k2, ssk, p1.

Row 7: P2tog, k2, yo, k3, *p1, k3, yo, k2, p3tog, k2, yo, k3; rep from * to last 8 sts, p1, k3, yo, k2, p2tog.

Row 9: P1, k2, k2tog, k2, yo, *p1, yo, k2, ssk, k2, p1, k2, k2tog, k2, yo; rep from * to last 8 sts, p1, yo, k2, ssk, k2, p1.

Row 11: P1, k1, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, *p1, k1, yo, k2, ssk, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, k2, yo, k1; rep from * to last 8 sts, p1, k1, yo, k2, ssk, k1, p1.

Row 13: P1, k2tog, k2, yo, k2, *p1, k2, yo, k2, ssk, p1, k2tog, k2, yo, k2; rep from * to last 8 sts, p1, k2, yo, k2, ssk, p1.

Row 15: P2tog, k2, yo, k3, *p1, k3, yo, k2, p3tog, k2, yo, k3; rep from * to last 8 sts, p1, k3, yo, k2, p2tog.

Row 17: P1, yo, k2, ssk, k2, *p1, k2, k2tog, k2, yo, p1, yo, k2, ssk, k2; rep from * to last 8 sts, p1, k2, k2tog, k2, yo, p1.

Row 19: P1, k1, yo, k2, ssk, k1, *p1, k1, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, p1, k1, yo, k2, ssk, k1; rep from * to last 8 sts, p1, k1, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, p1.

Row 21: P1, k2, yo, k2, ssk, *p1, k2tog, k2, yo, k2,

p1, k2, yo, k2, ssk; rep from * to last 8 sts, p1, k2tog, k2, yo, k2, p1.

Row 23: P1, k3, yo, k2, *p3tog, k2, yo, k3, p1, k3, yo, k2; rep from * to last 8 sts, p3tog, k2, yo, k3, p1.

Row 25: P1, yo, k2, ssk, k2, *p1, k2, k2tog, k2, yo, p1, yo, k2, ssk, k2; rep from * to last 8 sts, p1, k2, k2tog, k2, yo, p1.

Row 27: P1, k1, yo, k2, ssk, k1, *p1, k1, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, p1, k1, yo, k2, ssk, k1; rep from * to last 8 sts, p1, k1, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, p1.

Row 29: P1, k2, yo, k2, ssk, *p1, k2tog, k2, yo, k2, p1, k2, yo, k2, ssk; rep from * to last 8 sts, p1, k2tog, k2, yo, k2, p1.

Row 31: P1, k3, yo, k2, *p3tog, k2, yo, k3, p1, k3, yo, k2; rep from * to last 8 sts, p3tog, k2, yo, k3, p1.

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Row 32: K1, *p6, k1; rep from * across.
Rep these 32 rows for pattern st.

Begin

First Half

CO 79 sts. K 5 rows in Garter Stitch.

Work 6 total rep of Diamond Lace Stitch, keeping the first and last 4 sts in Garter stitch.

End the last rep with row 31 (191 rows in pattern stitch) Cut yarn, leaving a 6" tail for weaving in later. Place all sts onto a holder.

Second Half

Work same as first half; do not cut yarn.

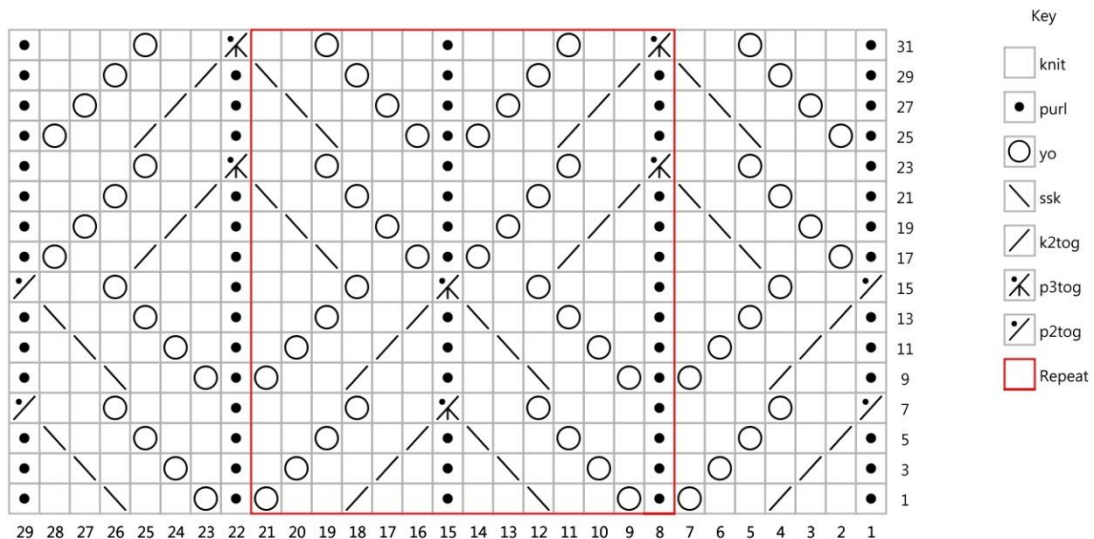
Join the first and second half tog using Kitchener stitch.

Finishing

Block to measurements. Weave in all ends.
