**KNITCOL AND GALWAY SPORT  
Fairisle Hat**



**Approximate Finished Size: 22" circumference, 18 ¼" brim**

**Materials:**

**Knitcol: 1—50g ball, color 074**

**Galway Sport: 1—50g ball, color 09 Black**

**Gauge:** 22 sts= 4" in st st on US Size 6 (4mm) knitting needle *after blocking*.

**Needles/Notions:** US Size 5 (3.75mm) and 6 (4mm) 16" circular knitting needle, US Size 6 (4mm) DPNs, 1 st marker, tapestry needle.

ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CO= cast on, dec= decrease, DPNs= double pointed needles, inc= increase, k= knit, k2tog= knit two stitches together, m= marker, m1= make one increase, mm= millimeter, pm= place marker, p = purl, rnd= round, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tog- together

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Rib Pattern (Multiple of 4 sts)

Rib Rnd: \*K2, p2; rep from \* across.

## Begin

### Brim

With Knitcol and smaller needle, Long-tail CO 100 sts. Join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Pm to mark beg of the rnd. Work in Rib Pattern until piece measures 2" from CO edge.

Inc Rnd: \*K5, m1; rep from \* around. 120 sts on needle.

### Body

Switch to larger needle and work Fairisle Pattern rnds 1-6 five times total.

### Shape Crown

Break Galway Sport and work just in Knitcol. Switch to DPNs when they aren't enough sts to fit comfortably around the circular needle.

Rnd 1 \*K10, k2tog; rep from \*.

Rnd 2 \*K9, k2tog; rep from \*.

Rnd 3 \*K8, k2tog; rep from \*.

Rnd 4 \*K7, k2tog; rep from \*.

Rnd 5 \*K6, k2tog; rep from \*.

Rnd 6 \*K5, k2tog; rep from \*.

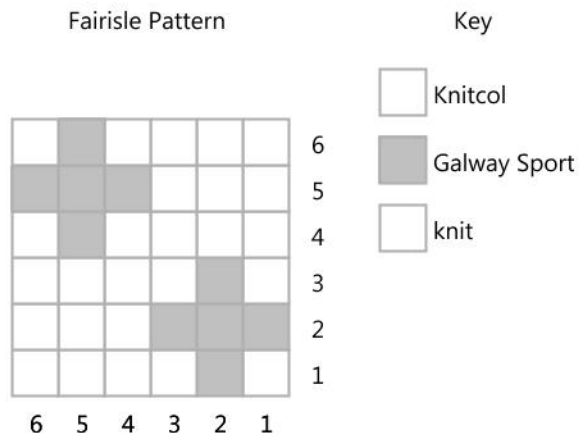
Rnd 7 \*K4, k2tog; rep from \*.

Rnd 8 \*K2, k2tog; rep from \*.

Rnd 9 \*K2, k2tog; rep from \*.

Rnd 10 \*K1, k2tog; rep from \*. Cut yarn, leaving a 6" tail. Thread tapestry needle and gather the sts on the needle tog. Pull tight and secure. Fasten off.

### Finishing

Weave in all ends and block.

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
