

PLYMOUTH YARN®

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F758

LINEN CONCERTO
Modular Shawl



Approximate Finished Dimensions 60” wingspan, 27” center length *after blocking*

Materials:

Linen Concerto: 6—50G balls, color 77 Terra Mix

Gauge: 20 sts= 4” in garter stitch on US Size 7 (4.5mm) knitting needle *after blocking*.

Needles/Notions: US Size 7 (4.5mm)- 2 sets of 24” circular knitting needle, 1 stitch marker, 1 tapestry needle.

ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CO= cast on, dec= decrease, inc= increase, k= knit, k2tog= knit two stitches together, m= marker, mm= millimeter, pm= place marker, p2sso= pass 2 slipped stitches over, p = purl, rep= repeat, RS= right side, sl = slip, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tog = together, WS = Wrong Side, yo = yarn over

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Garter Stitch= Knit every row.

Part 1.

Tab CO 3 sts. K6 rows in garter st, do not turn on last row. Instead, pick up and k3 sts along the side edge of the piece, pick up and k3 sts along the CO edge.

9 sts total on needle.

Row 1 (WS): K4, p1 (center stitch), pm, k4.

Row 2 (RS): K2, yo, k to m, yo, sl m, k1, yo, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2—4 sts inc'd.

13 sts on needle.

Row 3: K to 1 st before m, p1, sl m, k to end of row.

Rep the last 2 rows 30 times more—120 sts inc'd.

133 sts on needle.

Next Row (RS): K2, yo, k to m, yo, sl m, k1, yo, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2—4 sts inc'd.

137 sts on needle. Cut yarn, leaving a 4" tail for weaving in, and set aside (leave the sts on the circular.)

Part 2.

With the second circular needle, CO 3 sts.

Row 1 (WS): K across all sts.

Row 2 (RS): K2, yo, k to end—1 st inc'd. 4 sts on needle.

Rep the last 2 rows 34 times more--34 sts inc'd.

38 sts on needle.

Part 3.

(In this part, you will be joining part 1 and 2 tog. Have WS of both parts 1 and 2 facing you.)

Row 1 (WS): K38 sts of Part 2, k1 st of Part 1, turn.

Row 2 (RS): K2tog, k38.

Rep the last 2 rows 67 times more, end having worked row 2 (a RS Row).

Next Row (WS): K38 sts of Part 2, p1 of Part 1, sl m, k 68 sts to end of row. Cut yarn, leaving a 4" tail.

107 sts on needle. Set aside.

Part 4.

With the second circular needle, CO 3 sts.

Row 1 (WS): K across.

Row 2 (RS): K to last 2 sts, yo, k2—1 sts inc'd. 4 sts on needle.

Row 3 (WS): K across. Rep the last 2 rows 34 more times—34 sts inc'd. 38 sts on needle.

Part 5.

(In this part, you will be joining Part 4 with Parts 1, 2 and 3.)

Row 1 (RS): K37 sts of part 4, k2tog (joining last st of Part 4 with first st of the original Part 1), turn.

Row 2 (WS): K38.

Row 3 (RS): K37, k2tog (joining last st of Part 4 with first st of the original Part 1), turn.

Rep the last 2 rows 67 times more (you will have reached the center m). Work row 2 (a WS Row) once more.

77 sts on needle.



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Part 6.

(You will now be making a center diamond with Parts 5 and 3.)

Row 1 (RS): (Remove m when you get to it) K37, sl 2-k1-p2sso, k37—2 sts dec'd. 75 sts on needle.

Row 2: K across, purling the center st.

Row 3 (RS): K to 1 st before center st, sl 2-k1-p2sso, k to end of row—2 sts dec'd. 73 sts on needle. Rep the last 2 rows 35 times more—70 sts dec'd. 3 sts on needle.

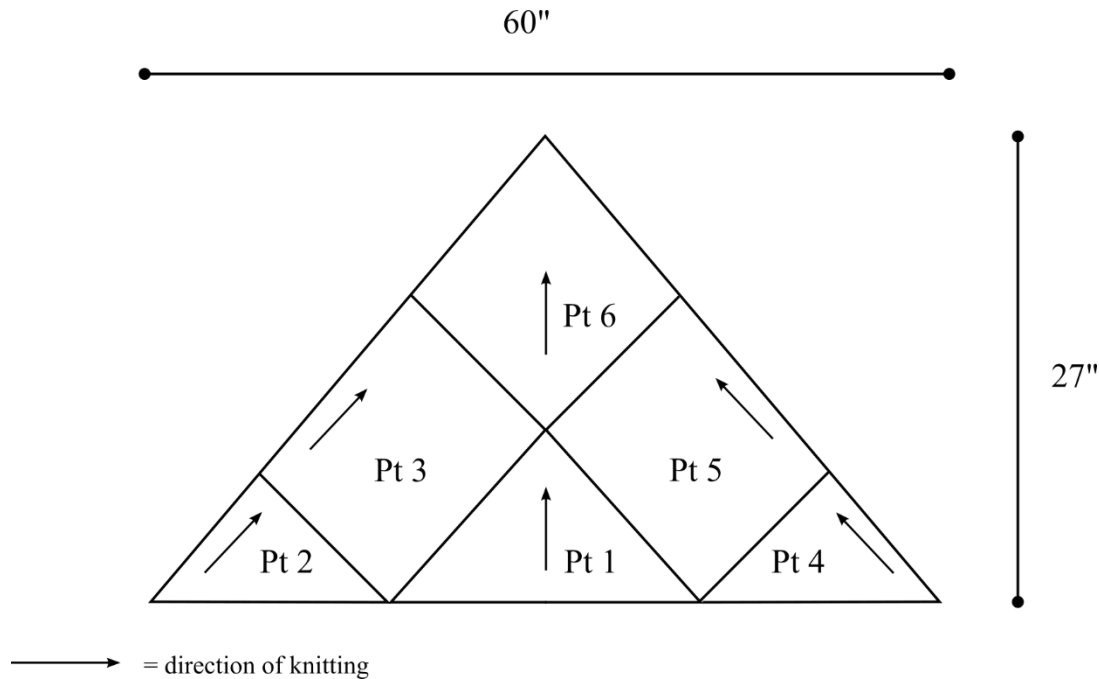
Next Row: K1, p1, k1.

Next Row: Sl 2-k1-p2sso- cut yarn and draw through last st.

Finishing

Weave in all ends and block.

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
