

**NETTLE GROVE
One Ball Triangle Scarf**



Approximate Finished Measurements: 50" long x 17 ½" at widest point *after blocking*

Materials:

Nettle Grove: 1—50G ball, color 37 Mermaid

Gauge: 12 sts, 20 rows = 4" in st st on US Size 9 (5.5mm) needle *after blocking*,

Needles/Notions: US Size 9 (5.5mm)- 24" circular needle

Begin

CO 3 sts.

Setup

Row 1 (RS): K2, yo, k1—1 st inc'd. 4 sts.

Row 2: K across.

Row 3: K2, yo, k2—1 st inc'd. 5 sts.

Row 4: K2, p1, k2.

Increase Pattern Stitch

Row 1 (RS): K2, yo, k to end of row—1 st inc'd.

Row 2: K2, p to last 2 sts, k2. Rep these last 2 rows forty-six times more. 52 sts on needle.

Decrease Pattern Stitch

Row 1 (RS): K2, ssk, (yo, ssk, k2) across—1 st dec'd. 51 sts on needle.

Row 2: K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 3: K2, ssk, k to end—1 st dec'd. 50 sts on needle.

Rows 4-6: Same as rows 2 and 3—1 st dec'd. 49 sts on needle.

Row 7: K2, ssk, (yo, ssk, k2) across to last st, k1—1 st dec'd. 48 sts on needle.

Rows 8-12: Same as rows 2 and 3—2 sts dec'd. 46 sts on needle.

Row 13: K2, ssk, (yo, ssk, k2) across to last 2 sts, k2—1 st dec'd.

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45 sts on needle.

Rows 14-18: Same as rows 2 and 3—2 sts dec'd.

43 sts on needle.

Row 19: K2, ssk, (yo, ssk, k2) across to last 3 sts, k3—1 st dec'd.

42 sts on needle.

Rows 20-24: Same as rows 2 and 3—2 sts dec'd.

40 sts on needle. Rep row 1-24 rows two times more, then work rows 1-20.

6 sts on needle.

Next Row: K2, ssk, k2—1 st dec'd.

5 sts on needle.

Next Row: K2, p1, k2.

Next Row: K2, ssk, k1—1 st dec'd.

4 sts on needle.

Next Row: K4.

Next Row: K2, ssk—1 st dec'd.

3 sts on needle. BO 3 sts on next row.

Finishing

Wet block the shawl to measurements, pinning out the center point.

Tassels (Optional): Using a piece of cardboard, (Or a book! or an ipad mini!) that measures 5 ½" wide, wrap 60 times around. Fasten off the tassel at the top through all the strands. Take off the cardboard. Then, wrap the yarn around the top 1" of the tassel around the entire tassel. Secure the ends and fasten off. Attach the tassel to the end of the scarf. Make another tassel and repeat. Weave in all ends.

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
