## WoCa Seed Stitch Hat



**To Fit Average Adult**

**Approximate Finished Circumference: 18" Brim, 22" at widest**

### **Materials:**

**WoCa: 2—50g balls, color 81 Gold**

**Gauge:** 20 sts, 28 rows sts= 4" in st st on US Size 8 (5mm) knitting needle *after blocking*,

**Needles/Notions:** US Size 6 (4mm) and 8 (5mm): 16" circular, US Size 8 (5mm) DPNs, US Size H-8 (5mm) crochet hook, scrap yarn, 1 stitch marker, cable needle.

The brim is double thick for a warm and stable hat.

ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CO= cast on, dec= decrease, DPNs= double pointed needles, inc= increase, k= knit, k2tog= knit two stitches together, m= marker, mm= millimeter, PM= place marker, p = purl, pss= pass slipped stitch over, rep= repeat, rnd= round, RS= right side, sl = slip, ssk = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st

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## 2x2 Rib

Rnd 1: \*K2, p2; rep from \* across.

Rep this rnd for pattern st.

## Cable and Seed Pattern

(multiple of 23 sts)

Rnds 1, 5, 7, 9, 11:

\*K12, p1, (k1, p1)5 times; rep from \*.

Rnds 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12:

\*K12, k1, (p1, k1)5 times; rep from \*

Rnd 3: \*Sl 6 sts to cable needle and hold to front, k6, k6 from cable needle, p1, (k1, p1)5 times; rep from \*.

Rep these 12 rnds for pattern st.

## **Begin**

### Brim

With crochet hook and scrap yarn, chain a little more than 92. Cut scrap yarn. With smaller circular needle, pick up and k 92 sts from the crochet chain. Join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. PM. Work in 2x2 rib for 4". Unzip the crochet chain scrap yarn and transfer the cast on sts to the larger circular needle. Fold the work in half, with RS facing and needles parallel to one another, and work as follows: \*(k tog 1 stitch from front needle and 1 st from back needle)4 times, m1; rep from \* across.

115 sts on needle.

### Body

With larger circular needle, work Cable and Seed Pattern rnds 1-12 three times, then work rnds 1-6 once more. (42 rnds in pattern)

### Shape Crown

(Switch to DPNs when necessary.)

Rnd 1: \*Ssk, k8, k2tog, (k2tog)5 times, k1; rep from \* across. 80 sts on needle.

Rnd 2: \*Ssk, k6, k2tog, (k2tog)3 times; rep from \* across. 55 sts on needle.

Rnd 3: \*Ssk, k4, (k2tog)2 times, k1; rep from \* across. 40 sts on needle.

Rnd 4: \*Ssk, k2, (k2tog)2 times; rep from \* across. 25 sts on needle.

Rnd 5: \*Ssk, k2tog, k1; rep from \* across. 15 sts on needle.

Rnd 6: \*Sl 1-k2tog-ssso; rep from \* across. 5 sts on needle.

Cut yarn, drawn through rem sts. Fasten off.

Pom Pom: With the leftover yarn, make a 2 1/2" pom pom and attached to the top of the crown securely.

Weave in all ends.

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
