RESERVE WORSTED Split Cowl



Approximate Finished Measurement: 21 ½" wide x 8 ½" height

Materials:

Reserve Worsted: 1—100g skein, color 106 Vintage Violet

Gauge: 20 sts, 28 rows= 4" in st st on US size 7 (4.5mm) needles *after blocking*,

22 sts = 4" in Pattern Stitch on US Size 7 (4.5mm) needles *after blocking*.

Needles/Notions: US Size 7 (4.5mm) 24" circular knitting needle.

ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CO= cast on, cont= continue, dec= decrease, inc= increase, k= knit, k1tbl= knit one stitch through back loop, kf&b= knit into the front and back of stitch, k2tog= knit two stitches together, m= marker, p= purl, p2tog= purl two stitches together, p2togtbl= purl two stitches together through the back loop, pm= place marker, rem= remain(ing), rep= repeat, rnd= round, RS= right side, ssk = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st= stitch, st st = stockinette st, WS= wrong side, yo= yarn over

Pattern Stitch (Multiple of 14 sts)

Do not count the stitches on rows 3, 4, or 5. The stitch count will be restored after working row 1, 2, 6, 7 and 8.

Row 1 (WS): *K1, p1tbl, p4, (p1tbl)twice, p4, p1tbl, k1; rep from * across.

Row 2: *P1, k1tbl, k4, (k1tbl)twice, k4, k1tbl, p1; rep from * across.

Row 3: *K1, p2tog, p3, (p1tbl)twice, p3, p2togtbl, k1; rep from * across.

Row 4: *P1, ssk, k2, (k1tbl)twice, k2, k2tog, p1; rep from * across.

Row 5: *K1, p2tog, p1, p1tbl, (yo)twice, p1tbl, p1, p2togtbl, k1; rep from * across.

Row 6: *P1, ssk, k1tbl, drop the extra yo of next stitch, then work (k1, p1)4 times into the existing yo, k1tbl, k2tog, p1; rep from * across.

Row 7: Same as row 1.

Row 8: *P1, k1tbl, k4, (k1tbl)twice, k4, k1tbl, p1; rep from * across.

Rep these 8 rows for pattern stitch.

Garter Stitch= Knit on RS and WS Rows.

Begin

Cowl

Long-tail CO 110 sts. Work 5 rows in Garter Stitch.

Inc Row (RS): K3, (k6, kf&b, k6)8x, k3—8 sts inc'd.

118 sts on needle.

Work 32 rows in Pattern Stitch, keeping the first and last 3 sts of every row in Garter Stitch.

Dec Row (WS): K3, (k2, k2tog, k6, k2tog, k2)8x, k3—16 sts dec'd.

102 sts on needle. Work in Garter Stitch until piece measures 8 ½" from CO edge. BO all sts on next row. Block the cowl, pinning out the wavy CO edge. Seam 3 ½" of the sides together. Weave in all ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CO= cast on, cont= continue, dec= decrease, inc= increase, k= knit, k1tbl= knit one stitch through back loop. kf&b= knit into the front and back of stitch, k2tog- knit two stitches together, m= marker, p= purl, p2tog= purl two stitches together, p2togtbl= purl two stitches together through the back loop, pm= place marker, rem= remain(ing), rep= repeat, rnd= round, RS= right side, ssk = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st= stitch, st st = stockinette st, WS= wrong side, yo= yarn over
