

## RESERVE FINGERING Asymmetrical Shawl



Approximately 54” wingspan  
*after blocking*

### Materials:

**Reserve Fingering: 1—100G skein, color 204 Teal Harbor**

**Gauge:** 17 sts= 4” in st st on US Size 8 (5mm) knitting needle *after blocking*.

**Needles/Notions:** US Size 8 (5mm) 24” circular knitting needle.

Notes: The pattern is worked from one corner, with increases worked at one edge.

### Begin

CO 7 sts.

### Slip Stitch Section

**Row 1 (WS):** Sl 1 st purlwise wyif, k4, yo, k2.

**Row 2:** Sl 1 st purlwise wyib, (k1, yo)twice, k to end of row.

**Row 3:** Sl 1 st purlwise wyif, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

**Row 4:** Sl 1 st purlwise wyib, (k1, yo)twice, k1, \*sl 1 purlwise wyif, k1; rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Row 5:** \*Sl 1 st purlwise wyif, k1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k1, yo, k2.

Rep rows 2-5 eighteen times more—115 total sts inc’d.

122 sts on needle.

### Stockinette Stitch Section

**Rows 1, 3, 5 (RS):** Sl 1 st purlwise wyib, (k1, yo)twice, k to end of row.

**Rows 2 and 4:** Sl 1 st purlwise wyif, k1, p to last 2 sts yo, k2.

**Row 6:** Sl 1 st purlwise wyif, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

Rep rows 1-6 eight times more—81 sts inc’d.

203 sts on needle.

### Garter Stitch Section

**Row 1 (RS):** Sl 1 st purlwise wyib, (k1, yo)twice, k to end of row.

**Row 2:** Sl 1 st purlwise wyif, k to last 2 sts yo, k2.

Rep rows 1-2 until you only have enough yarn left to bind off.

ABBREVIATIONS: beg= beginning, BO= bind off, CO= cast on, cont= continue, inc= increase, k = knit, mm= millimeter, p= purl, Rep= repeat, RS= right side, sl = slip, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, WS = Wrong Side, wyib= with yarn in back, wyif= with yarn in front, yo= yarn over

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BO all sts on next row using your favorite stretchy bind off method. We used “Jeny’s surprisingly stretchy bind off.”

## Finishing

Weave in all ends and wet block, submerging the shawl in cool water for at least 15 minutes. Roll the excess moisture out of the shawl and lay it out flat to dry.

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
