CUZCO CASHMERE Cabled Hat



Approximate Circumference: 17" without stretching.

Hat is designed with approximately 4-5" of negative ease.

Materials:

Cuzco Cashmere: 1—50G ball, color 13 Wild Rose

Gauge: 24 sts, 32 rows = 4" using US size 4 (3.5mm) needles in st st *after blocking*,
24 sts = 3 1/2" in **Cable Pattern** on US Size 4 (3.5mm) needles *after blocking*.

Needles: US Size 2 (2.75mm) and 4 (3.5mm)- 16" circular, US Size 4 (3.5mm) DPNs, 1 st marker (m), 1 cable needle.
Work either the written or charted **Cable Pattern**. If you are working from the chart, work all rnds from right to left.

ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, C4B= sl 2 sts to cable needle and hold to back, k2, k2 from cable needle, C4F= sl 2 sts to cable needle and hold to front, k2, k2 from cable needle, CO= cast on, DPNs= double pointed needles, k=knit, k2tog= knit two stitches together, kf&b= knit into the front and back of stitch, m= marker, mm= millimeter, p= purl, p2tog= purl two stitches together, pm= place marker, rep= repeat, rnd= round, ssk = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), T3B= sl 1 st to cable needle and hold to back, k2, p1 from cable needle, T3F= sl 2 sts to cable needle and hold to front, p1, k2 from cable needle, tog = together

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Cable Pattern (Multiple of 24 sts)

Rnd 1: *K2, p2, k4, p2, k2, p2, k8, p2; rep from * around.

Rnd 2: *K2, p2, k4, p2, k2, p12; rep from * around.

Rnd 3: Same as rnd 1.

Rnd 4: *(T3F, T3B)twice, p2, k8, p2; rep from * around.

Rnd 5: *(P1, k4, p1)twice, p2, k8, p2; rep from * around.

Rnd 6: *P1, C4B, p2, C4F, p13; rep from * around.

Rnd 7: Same as rnd 5.

Rnd 8: *(T3B, T3F)twice, p2, k8, p2; rep from * around.

Rep these 8 rnds for pattern st.

Begin

With smaller circular needle, long-tail CO 110 sts. Join in the rnd being careful not to twist sts. Pm. Work in 1x1 rib (k1 st, p1 st) for 13 rnds. Switch to larger circular needle.

Setup Rnd: *K2, p2, (kf&b)twice, p2, k2, p2, k8, p2; rep from * around. 120 sts on needle.

Begin Cable Pattern

Work rnds 1-8 of **Cable Pattern** 6 times. (48 rnds worked in **Cable Pattern**).

(Hat will measure approximately 7 1/2" from CO edge after all repeats have been worked- you may wish to work one more repeat if you want more slouch.)

Shape Crown (Switch to DPNs)

Rnd 1: *K2, p2, k4, p2, k2, p2, k2tog, k4, ssk, p2; rep from * around. 110 sts on needle.

Rnd 2: *K2, p2, k4, p2, k2, p2, k2tog, p6; rep from * around. 105 sts on needle.

Rnd 3: *K2, p2, k4, p2, k2, p2, ssk, p5; rep from * around. 100 sts on needle.

Rnd 4: *(T3F, T3B)twice, p2, k2tog, ssk, p2; rep from * around. 90 sts on needle.

Rnd 5: *(P1, k4, p1)twice, p2, k2, p2; rep from * around.

Rnd 6: *P1, sl 2 sts to cable needle and hold to back, k2 from needle, k2tog from cable needle, p2, sl 2 sts to cable needle and hold to front, ssk from needle, k2 from cable needle, p7; rep from * around. 80 sts on needle.


Rnd 7: unknit one st from previous rnd, *P2tog, k2tog, p1, ssk, p2tog, k1; rep from * around. 48 sts on needle.

Rnd 8: *K2, k2tog; rep from * around. 36 sts on needle.

Rnd 9: *K1, k2tog; rep from * around. 24 sts on needle.

Rnd 10: *K2tog; rep from * around. 12 sts on needle. Cut yarn and draw through rem sts. Weave in all ends.

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
