# PLYMOUTH YARN®

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## ENCORE CHUNKY COLORSPUN Diagonal Eyelet Scarf



Approximate Dimensions: 9" wide x 53" long

#### Materials:

Encore Chunky Colorspun: 2—100g balls, color 7203

**Gauge**: 12 sts, 24 rows = 4" in garter stitch (knit every row) on US Size 10  $\frac{1}{2}$  (6.5mm) knitting needle *after blocking*.

Needles/Notions: US Size 10 1/2 (6.5mm) straight knitting needle.

ABBREVATIONS: CO= cast on, dec = decrease, inc = increase, k = knit, k2tog = knit two stitches together, kf&b = knit into the front and back of stitch, mm= millimeter, p = purl, RS= right side, sl = slip, ssk = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tog = together, WS = Wrong Side, yo= yarn over

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### Begin

Increase Corner CO 1 st. <u>Row 1:</u> Kf&b—1 st inc'd. Mark this side of your knitting as a RS—all odd numbered rows are RS Rows. 2 sts on needle. <u>Rows 2-34:</u> Kf&b, k to end of row—1 st inc'd. 35 sts on needle.

### Eyelet Pattern

You will now maintain having 35 sts on your needle for the main body of the scarf. <u>Row 35:</u> Kf&b, \*(yo)twice, k1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2tog. <u>Row 36:</u> K2, \*drop the 2 yo's of previous row, k1; rep from \* to last st, k1. <u>Row 37:</u> Kf&b, k to last 2 sts, k2tog. <u>Row 38:</u> K across. <u>Rows 39-68:</u> Rep the last 2 rows (This will create 17 garter ridges from the dropped stitches). Rep rows 35-68 four times more. Rep rows 35 and 36 once more.

<u>Decrease Corner</u> <u>Next Row:</u> Ssk, k to end of row—1 st dec'd. Rep this row until 2 sts remain. Ssk on last row and cut yarn, leaving a 4-6" tail for weaving in.

Weave in all ends. Block lightly if desired.

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
