## AREQUIPA FUR and AREQUIPA WORSTED Hat



**Approximate Hat Circumference: 21 ½"**

### **Materials:**

**Arequipa Fur:** 1—50g ball, color 201 Putty

**Arequipa Worsted:** 1—100g ball, color 301 Putty

**Gauge:** 12 sts, 18 rows= 4" in st st on US Size 10 (6mm) knitting needle holding one strand of Fur and one strand of worsted together *after blocking*.

**Needles/Notions:** US Size 10 (6mm) 16" circular knitting needles and DPNs, 1 stitch marker, tapestry needle.

ABBREVIATIONS: beg= beginning, BO= bind off, CO= cast on cont= continue, dec = decrease, DPNs= double pointed needles, inc = increase, k = knit, k2tog= knit two stitches together, m= marker, mm= millimeter, pm= place marker, p = purl, Rep= repeat, rnd= round, RS= right side, sl = slip, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tog = together

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## **Begin**

Note: Worsted Merino Superwash, Encore, or Galway Worsted may be substituted for the Arequipa Worsted.

## **Begin**

### Hat Brim

With circular needle, one strand of Arequipa Fur and one strand of Arequipa Worsted held together, long-tail CO 64 sts. Join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Pm to mark beginning of rnd.

Rib Rnd: \*K1, p1; rep from \* around.

Rep this rnd for 4", Then, cont to work in st st in the rnd (k every rnd) until hat measures 6" from CO edge.

### Crown Shaping

(Switch to DPNs when there aren't enough sts to fit comfortably on the circular needle.)

Rnd 1: \*K6, k2tog; rep from \* around.

Rnd 2 and every other rnd: K around.

Rnd 3: \*K5, k2tog; rep from \* around.

Rnd 5: \*K4, k2tog; rep from \* around.

Rnd 7: \*K3, k2tog; rep from \* around.

Rnd 9: \*K2, k2tog; rep from \* around.

Rnd 11: \*K1, k2tog; rep from \* around.

Rnd 12: \*K2tog; rep from \* around.

8 sts remain on needle. Cut yarn, leaving a 4" tail, and thread tapestry needle. Gather up the remaining sts and draw tightly. Fasten off and secure.

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
