

### GALWAY ROVING Buttoned Cowl



**Approximate Dimensions:** 20”  
circumference x 10” long

#### **Materials:**

**Galway Roving:** 2—100g balls,  
color 28 Chocolate

**Gauge:** 8 sts= 4” in st st on US Size  
15 (10mm) knitting needles *after*  
*blocking.*

**Needles/Notions:** US Size 15 (10mm) 24”  
circular knitting needle, 1 st marker, 2  
buttons from Dill #370728—34mm each.

#### **Begin**

Long-tail CO 40 sts. Join in the rnd,  
being careful not to twist sts. Pm to  
mark beg of rnd.

**Rnds 1-10:** \*p1, k3, p1; rep from \*  
around.

**Rnds 11-20:** Knit around.

You will now be working flat, and  
adding a button placket. Remove the  
marker.

Turn work, so WS is facing, cable-  
CO 3 sts onto left hand needle. Then  
work the row as follows:

**Row 1 (WS):** P3, \*k2, p2; rep from \*  
across.

**Row 2:** K2, yo, p2tog, k2, \*p2, k2;  
rep from \* across to last st, k1.

**Rows 3, 5, 7:** Same as row 1.

**Row 4:** K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \*  
across to last st, k1.

**Row 6:** Same as row 2.

**Row 8:** Same as row 4.

BO all sts in rib on next row.

#### Finishing

Seam the cable CO edge of the placket down to the inside of the cowl. Sew on 2 buttons. Weave in all ends.

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
