

**HOMESTEAD**  
**Double Seed Stitch Cowl**



**Approximate Finished Measurements;**

**Circumference:** approximately 50" after blocking

**Height:** approximately 9" after blocking

**Materials:**

**Homestead:** 2—100g skeins, color 22 **Burnt Orange**

**Gauge:** 14 sts and 25 rows = 4" in Double Seed Stitch *after blocking*.

While exact gauge is not crucial, it will affect the size of the cowl and the amount of yarn used.

**Needles/Notions:** Size US 9 (5.5mm)

20" or 24" circular needle, or size needed to obtain gauge,

Removable stitch marker, Yarn needle.

**DOUBLE SEED STITCH COWL**

Cast on 180 sts. Join for working in the round, taking care not to twist. Place marker for beg of round.

Purl one round.

**Rnds 1 and 2:** \*K2, p2. Rep from \* to end of rnd.

**Rnds 3 and 4:** \*P2, k2. Rep from \* to end of rnd.

Work Rnds 1-4 until cowl measures 9" from cast on, ending with Rnd 4. Purl one round. Bind off.

**FINISHING**

Weave in ends. Block lightly to finished measurements.

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
