## JELLI BEENZ Kid's Hat and Cowl Set



**Hat to Fit: Baby, (Toddler, Child)**

**Approximate Finished Hat Circumference: 16", (17 ½, 18 ¾)**

**Approximate Cowl Dimensions: 20 ½" circumference x 7 ½" deep**

### Materials:

**Jelli Beenz: 1—100g ball each in Color 2383 Nectarine (MC) and 2235 Aqua (CC) for SET (Set includes one hat in any size and one cowl.)**

**Gauge:** 18 sts = 4" in Seed Stitch on US size 8 (5mm) needles *after blocking*.

### **Needles:**

**For Hat:** US Size 7 (4.5mm) and 8 (5mm) 16" circular, US Size 8 (5mm) DPNs, 1 st marker.

**For Cowl:** US Size 7 (4.5mm) and 8 (5mm) 16" circular, 1 st marker.

ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CC= contrast color, CO= cast on, dec = decrease, DPNs= double pointed needles, inc = increase, k = knit, m= marker, mm= millimeter, MC= main color, pm= place marker, p = purl, p3tog= purl three stitches together, rep= repeat, rnd= round, RS= right side, sl = slip, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tog = together

Pattern for hat is written for smallest size, with larger sizes in parenthesis. If only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. The cowl is just one size.

## Seed Stitch

Rnd 1: \*K1, p1; rep from \* around.

Rnd 2: \*P1, k1; rep from \* around.

Rep these 2 rnds for pattern stitch.

## **Hat**

### Begin

With smaller circular needle and CC, long-tail CO 72, (76, 84) sts. Join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Pm to mark beg of rnd.

Rib Rnd: \*K2, p2; rep from \* around.

Rep this rnd for 2", (2 ½, 3), on last rnd inc 0, (2, 0) sts evenly around.

72, (78, 84) sts on needle.

Switch to larger circular needle and MC. K 1 rnd. Work in Seed Stitch for 4", (4 ½, 5), end having worked rnd 2.

### Crown Shaping

(Switch to DPNs when there aren't enough sts to fit comfortably around.)

Rnd 1: \*K1, p3tog, k1, p1; rep from \* around.

48, (52, 56) sts.

Rnd 2: \*P1, k1; rep from \* around.

Rnd 3: \*K1, p3tog; rep from \* around.

24, (26, 28) sts.

Rnd 4: \*P1, k1; rep from \* around.

Rnd 5: \*K1, p3tog; rep from \* around to last 0, (2, 0) sts, k1, p1.

12, (14, 14) sts.

Rnd 6: \*P1, k1; rep from \* around.

Rnd 7: \*P2tog; rep from \* around.

6, (7, 7) sts. Cut yarn, draw through remaining sts. Cut yarn, draw through remaining sts. Fasten off. If desired, Make a pom pom with CC and attach to top of hat. Weave in all ends.

## **Cowl**

### Begin

With smaller circular needle and CC, long-tail CO 92 sts. Join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Pm to mark beg of rnd.

Rib Rnd: \*K2, p2; rep from \* around. Rep this rnd for 1".

Switch to larger circular needle and MC. K 1 rnd.

Work in Seed Stitch for 5 ½". K 1 rnd. Switch to smaller circular needle and CC. Work Rib Rnd for 1". BO all sts on next rnd in rib.
