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KIMERA Baby's Garter Stitch Vest



To Fit Size: 0-3, (6-12, 18-24) months

Approximate Finished Chest Measurement: 16", (18, 20) after blocking

Length: 7", (8, 9)

Materials: Kimera: 2, (2, 2)—50g balls, color 17

Gauge: 24 sts, 48 rows= 4" in garter stitch (k every row) on US Size 4 (3.5mm) knitting needles *after blocking*. **Needles/Notions:** US Size 4 (3.5mm) 24" circular needle, 4 st holders, 1 button from Dill #300445—23mm.

ABBREVATIONS: beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CO= cast on, dec = decrease, inc = increase, k = knit, mm= millimeter, p = purl, RS= right side, sl = slip, sts) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tog = together, WS = Wrong Side

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The pattern is written for smallest size, with larger sizes in parenthesis. If only one number is given, it applies to all sizes.

Begin

<u>Body</u> Long-tail CO 108, (120, 132) sts. Work in garter stitch, marking the first row as a WS Row. Work even for $4\frac{1}{4}$, (4\frac{3}{4}, 5\frac{1}{4}) from CO edge, end having worked a WS Row.

Divide Front and Back

Next Row (RS): K25, (28, 31) sts, BO 10 sts, K38, (44, 50) sts, BO 10 sts, k25, (28, 31).

Place the first set of 25, (28, 31) sts and the center 38, (44, 50) sts onto a holder.

You will now be working just on the 25, (28, 31) remaining sts, which will be left front.

Left Front

For boys only: If you are making this for a boy, work for $1\frac{1}{4}$, $(1\frac{3}{4}, 2\frac{1}{4})$, then work buttonhole on next RS Row as follows:

Buttonhole Row (RS): K to last 8 sts, BO 2 sts, k6. On next row, CO 2 sts over the BO section.

For both boys and girls: Work until vest measures $6\frac{1}{2}$, $(7\frac{1}{2}, 8\frac{1}{2})$ from CO edge, end having worked a RS Row. Shape Neck (WS): BO 13, (15, 17) sts, k to end of row. K 1 row.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next row, and then the following alternate row. K 1 more row. 10, (11, 12) sts remain. Cut yarn, leaving a 20" tail. Place all sts onto a holder.

Right Front

SI the 25, (28, 31) sts from the holder onto needle. Reattach yarn, ready to work a WS Row.

For girls only: If you are making this for a girl, work for 1 1/4", (13/4, 2 1/4), then work buttonhole on next RS Row as follows:

Buttonhole Row (RS): K6, BO 2 sts, k to end of row. On next row, CO 2 sts over the BO section.

For both boys and girls: Work until vest measures 6 ½", (7 ½, 8 ½) from CO edge, end having worked a WS Row. Shape Neck (RS): BO 13, (15, 17) sts, k to end of row. K 1 row. Dec 1 st at neck edge on next row, and then the following alternate row. K 1 more row.

10, (11, 12) sts remain. Cut yarn, leaving a 20" tail. Place sts onto a holder.

Back


SI the 38, (44, 50) sts from the holder onto needle. Reattach yarn, ready to work a WS Row. Work until vest measures $6\frac{1}{2}$, (7 $\frac{1}{2}$, 8 $\frac{1}{2}$) from CO edge, end having worked a WS Row.

Shape Neck (RS): K 12, (13, 14), attach a new strand of yarn, BO 14, (18, 22) sts, k to end of row. 12, (13, 14) sts remain for each shoulder. Dec 1 st at neck edge on next row, and then the following alternate row. 10,

(11, 12) sts for each shoulder remain. K 1 more row. Kitchener stitch the back shoulder sts to the left and right front shoulder stitches.



Block to measurements. Sew button onto front. Weave in all
