# TOYBOX RAINBOW <br> <br> Baby Hat and Socks 

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To Fit Size: 0-6 months, (9-12, 12-24, 2T-4T)
Hat Circumference: 14 ", $(16,18,20)$
Sock Circumference: $51 / 2 "$ (intended for toddler)

## Materials:

Toybox Rainbow: 1, (1, 1, 2)—100g balls for set (either size hat) in color 108 Denim
Gauge: 20 sts, 26 rows $=4$ " in st st on US size $7(4.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ needles/

## Needles/Notions:

For Hat: US Size 7 ( 4.5 mm ) DPNs, US Size 5 ( 3.75 mm ) 24" circular needle, 6 stitch markers-one in a different color than the rest, 1 st holder
For Socks: US Size 5 ( 3.75 mm ) and 7 ( 4.5 mm ) DPNs, 1 st marker, 1 st marker.

The hat pattern is written for the smaller size, with larger sizes in parenthesis. If only one number is given, it applies to all sizes.

## Special Abbreviations

$\mathbf{m 1 R}=$ With left hand needle, place the tip of the needle from back to front into the bar between the sts on the needle, k this st.
$\mathbf{m 1 L}=$ With left hand needle, place the tip of the needle from font to back into the bar between the sts on the needle, k this st tbl.

## Begin

Hat
Crown
With US Size $7(4.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ DPNs, CO 10 sts, dividing them amongst 3 needles. Join in the rnd and pm that is a different color than the rest.
Rnd 1: (Kf\&b)10 times-10 sts inc'd. 20 sts on needle.
Rnd 2: (K2, pm, k2)5 times.
Rnd 3: (K1, m1R, k to $\mathrm{m}, \mathrm{slm} \mathrm{m}, \mathrm{mlL}$ ) 5 times, k to end of rnd- 10 sts inc'd. 30 sts on needle.
Rnd 4: $K$ around.
Rep rnds 3 and 4 four, (five, six, seven) times more. 70, (80, 90, 100) sts on needle.
Work even until hat measures 5 ", ( $5^{1 / 4}, 5^{3 / 4}, 6 \frac{1}{4}$ ) from CO edge. (You may remove the extra st markers except for the beg of the rnd marker.)

ABBREVATIONS: beg= begin(ning), $\mathrm{BO}=$ bind off, $\mathrm{CO}=$ cast on, cont= continue, dec= decrease, DPNs= double pointed needles, $\mathrm{inc}=$ increase, $\mathrm{k}=\mathrm{knit}$, $\mathrm{k} 2 \mathrm{tog}=\mathrm{knit}$ two stitches together, $\mathrm{kf} \& \mathrm{~b}=$ knit into the front and back, $\mathrm{m}=$ marker, $\mathrm{p}=$ purl, $\mathrm{p} 2 \mathrm{tog}=$ purl two stitches together, rem= remain(ing), rep= repeat, $\mathrm{RS}=$ right side, sl= slip, ssk = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st= stitch, st st = stockinette st, WS= wrong side, yo=yarn over

Next Rnd: BO 28, $(32,38,42)$ sts, k across $14,(16,16,18)$ sts and place these sts onto a holder, BO $14,(16,20,22)$ sts, k across $14,(16,16,18)$ sts.

Earflap: You will now be working back and forth in rows on the remaining $14,(16,16,18)$ sts on your needle. Purl one row.
Dec Row (RS): K1, ssk, k to 3 sts, k 2 tog , $\mathrm{k} 1-2$ sts dec'd. Rep the last 2 rows once more.
$10,(12,12,14)$ sts on needle. Work even for 5 rows.
Inc Row (RS): K1, m1R, k to last st, m1L, $\mathrm{k} 1-2$ sts inc'd. Purl one row.
Rep the last 2 rows once more. $14,(16,16,18)$ sts on needle.
Dec Row (RS): K1, ssk, k to 3 sts, k2tog, k1-2 sts dec'd.
Dec Row (WS): P1, p2tog, p to last 2 sts, p2togtbl, p1-2 sts dec'd.
Rep the last 2 rows twice more. $6,(8,8,10)$ sts on needle. BO all sts on next row.
Slip the $14,(6,16,18)$ sts from the holder onto your US Size $7(4.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ DPN. Work another earflap.
Finishing: With RS facing and circular needle, RS facing, pick up evenly and $\mathrm{k} 6,(8,8,10)$ sts along the earflap BO edge, pick up evenly and k 16 sts along the side of the earflap, pick up and 1 st for every BO stitch along the BO edge of the hat, pick up evenly and $k 16$ sts along the side edge of the earflap, pick up evenly and $k 6,(8,8,10)$ sts along the earflap BO edge, pick up evenly and $k 16$ sts along the side of the earflap, pick up and $k 1$ st for every BO st along the BO edge of the hat. $118,(128,138,148)$ sts on needle. Join in the rnd and pm. P 1 rnd, k 1 rnd. BO all sts in $p$ on next rnd. Weave in all ends.

Socks: With smaller DPNs, long-tail CO 28 sts. Join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Pm. Rib Rnd: *K1, p1; rep from * around. Rep this rnd 3 times more. Switch to larger DPNs. Work in st st for 4".

Shape Heel: Next Row (RS): K14, turn. You will now be working in rows just on these 14 sts. Place the other 14 sts onto a holder. Work 15 rows in st st.

## Turn Heel

Row 1 (WS): Sl 1, p8, p2tog, p1, turn.
Row 2: Sl 1, k5, k2tog, k1, turn.
Row 3: S1 1, p6, p2tog, p1, turn.
Row 4: Sl 1, k7, k2tog, k1, turn. 10 sts remain on needle.
Gusset: With the current working needle, pick up and k 8 sts down the side of the heel to sts on holder, with a second needle, k across the 14 sts on holder, with a third needle, pick up and k 8 sts along the side of the heel, k across 5 sts from original needle. Pm to mark beg of rnd- which is the center of the heel. 40 sts on needle; 13 sts on needles 1 and 3, 14 sts on needle 2.
Rnd 1: Knit around.
Rnd 2: (Needle 1) K to last 3 sts, k 2 tog, k 1 ,
(Needle 2) K across, (Needle 3) k1, ssk, k to end of rnd. Rep the last 2 rnds 5 times more.
28 sts on needle; 7 sts on needle 1 and 3,14 sts on needle 2 . Work 12 rnds even.
Shape Toe
Rnd 1: (Needle 1) K to last 3 sts, k 2 tog, k 1 (Needle 2) k1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1, (Needle 3) k1, ssk, k to end of rnd.
Rnd 2: K across all sts. Rep these 2 rnds four times more. 8 sts on needles. Rearrange the sts by knitting across sts from Needle 1. ( 4 sts on two needles remain). Kitchener st these sts with sts from Needle 2. Make another sock.
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
