

AREQUIPA BOUCLE Two Tone Hat



To Fit Average Adult
Approximate Finished Circumference:
19 ½” *without stretching.*

Materials:

Arequipa Boucle:
1—100g ball EACH in 2 different colors;
we used color 103 Silver (MC) and 105
Grey (CC)

Gauge: 14 sts, 18 rows= 4” in 2x2 Rib on US
size 10 (6mm) needles *after blocking.*

Needles: US Size 8 (5mm) 16” circular, US Size 10
(6mm) 16” circular and DPNs, 1 stitch marker.

Begin

With smaller circular needle and MC, long-tail
CO 68 sts. Join in the rnd, being careful not to
twist sts. Pm.

Rib Rnd: *K2, p2; rep from * around. Rep this
rnd for 3 ½”.

Switch to larger circular needle and CC. K 1
rnd. Work Rib Rnd for 4 ½” more- hat is now
8” from CO edge, dec 2 sts evenly across last
rnd. 66 sts on needle.

Crown Shaping

(Switch to DPNs when there aren’t enough sts
to fit comfortably around.)

Rnd 1: *Ssk, rib 7, k2tog; rep from * around.
54 sts on needle.

Rnds 2, 4, 6: K the k and p the p as they
appear.

Rnd 3: *Ssk, rib 5, k2tog; rep from * around. 42 sts on needle.

Rnd 5: *Ssk, rib 3, k2tog; rep from * around. 30 sts on needle.

Rnd 7: *Ssk, rib 1, k2tog; rep from * around. 18 sts on needle.

Rnd 8: *Sl 2-k1, p2sso; rep from * around. 6 sts on needle.

Cut yarn, draw through remaining sts. Fasten off. Weave in all ends.

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
