

**Estilo Hand Dyed
Lace Pattern Scarf**



Materials:

Estilo Hand Dyed: 1—100g skein, shown in color 1 Aqua Mix

Gauge: 24 sts= 4” in pattern st on US Size 4 knitting needle *after blocking*.

Needles: US Size 4 (3.5mm).

Approx. Finished Measurements: 8” x 55”

Scarf: (Multiple of 6 + 7)

Loosely cast on 49 sts.

Knit 4 rows.

Begin lace pattern:

Row 1(RS): K5, *(yo, sl 1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k3); repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2(WS): K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 3: K2, *(yo, sl 1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k3); repeat from * to last 5 sts, yo, sl 1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k2.

Row 4: K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2.

Repeat these 4 rows for lace pattern until almost out of yarn, leaving enough for 6 rows plus bind off, and ending with a WS row. Length will be about 50” unstretched at this point.

Knit 4 rows.

Bind off loosely.

Weave in all ends. Block out to measurements.

ABBREVIATIONS: k = knit, p= purl, RS= right side, sl = slip, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, WS = Wrong Side, pss0 = pass the slipped st over the k2tog, yo= yarn over.
