

HOT CAKES
Inside - Out Baby Blanket



Size: Approx. 33” square.

Materials:

Hot Cakes: 1—200g Cake
Shown in color 7- Beach Brights Mix;

1—100g ball Encore Worsted for trim. Shown in color 478- Neon Pink

Gauge: 20 sts = 4” in st st on US Size 7 needles.

Needles: 32’ or longer size US 6 needles for border; size US 7 dpns, 24” circular, and 32” circular size US 7, 4 stitch markers- one a different color.

Begin:

Using Size 7 dpns, cast on 8 sts.

Divide between 3 needles and join to work in the round.

Round 1: Knit around.

Round 2: *(K1, m1); repeat from * around: 16 sts.

Divide sts evenly on 4 dpns.- 4 on each needle.

Round 3: *(K1, m1, k to last st on needle, m1, k1); repeat from * around: 24 sts.

Round 4: Knit around.

Repeat rounds 3 & 4 until there are enough sts to change to a circular needle. At that time place markers where ends of doubles points were. Each section will be considered a “side”. Use a different color marker for the end of round. Change to longer needles as needed.

Continue until there are about 96 sts on each side: 384 sts total.

Change to solid color and smaller needles. (size US 6) Knit 1 round even with solid border color

Purl next even round. This establishes garter st for the border (knit 1 round, purl 1 round).

Begin increasing on the garter st border trim as follows:

Round 1: *(K1, m1, k to last st on “side”, m1, k1); repeat from * around.

Round 2: Purl around.

Round 3: Knit around.

Round 4: Purl around.

Continue to increase as established on every other odd numbered rounds.

Work until there are about 9 ridges, ending with a round 2 or 4.

Next round: Bind off very loosely knitwise. Weave in all ends.

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ABBREVIATIONS: k = knit, k2tog= knit two sts together, p = purl, p2tog = purl 2 sts together, RS= right side, st(s) = stitch(es), WS = wrong side, yo= yarn over, ch = chain, sk = skip, dc= double crochet, st(s) = stitch(es), sp = space, m1 = make 1 st = lift bar onto needle, knit into the back of it to increase 1 st., Kf&b = knit into the front and the back of the stitch.
