

**NATURAL BEBE**  
**Shell Flower Crochet Baby Throw**



**SIZE:** 20 x 25".

**MATERIALS:**

2—100g balls of Natural Bebe from Nako, shown in color 312

**HOOK:** Size H hook, or size needed for gauge.

**GAUGE:** 4 sc = 1".

**Shell Flower Pattern**

Multiple of 6 + 4

**Row 1 (RS):** Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in each remaining ch; ch 3 turn.

**Row 2:** Sk next 4 sc, in next sc work (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc): shell made; \*sk next 5 sc, in next sc work (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc): shell made; rep from \* across to last sc; dc in last sc; ch 3, turn.

**Row 3:** Make a shell in ch-2 sp of each shell across to turning ch; dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of turning ch-3; ch 3 turn.

Repeat row 3 for pattern.

With Natural Bebe and H hook, chain 88. Work in pattern stitch for 24", you will have 14 shells across each row. Do not cut yarn. Begin border: ch1, do not turn work. Work 1 sc in last dc and continue working sc in each dc and dc space along edge of blanket, sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc, ch 1, sc in same sc and in each sc along edge, working 3 sc in each corner. Continue to work in rounds for border, working a total of 2 rounds. Work 1 round of reverse single crochet around entire edge, sl st and fasten off.

Weave in all ends.

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
