

**KidSeta  
 Lace Cowl**



**Circumference: 34” at widest, Length: 9”**

**Materials:**

**KidSeta: 2—25g balls, color 81 Ecru**

**Gauge:** 16 sts and 22 rows = 4” in st st **double stranded** on a US 8 (5mm) needle. *Or size to obtain gauge,*

15 sts, 22 rows = 4” in Beehive Lace st on US Size 8 (5mm) using **double strand** or *size to obtain gauge.*

**Needles/Notions:** US Size 8 (5mm)-32” circular, 4 st markers (m).

**Beehive Lace St** (Multiple of 7 sts + 4)

**Rnd 1:** \*K2, yo, ssk, yo, sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo; rep from \* across to last 4 sts, k2, yo, ssk.

**Rnd 2:** \*P2tog, yo, p2, k3; rep from \* across to last 4 sts, P2tog, yo, p2.

**Rnd 3:** \*K2, yo, ssk, k3; rep from \* across to last 4 sts, k4.

**Rnd 4:** \*P2tog, yo, p2tog, k3; rep from \* across to last 4 sts, p2tog, yo, p2.

Rep these 4 rnds.

Work either the chart or the written instructions for the lace. When working the chart, work all rnds from right to left.

**Begin**

(Hold 2 strands of mohair together throughout.)

Long tail CO 132 sts. Join in the rnd and PM, being careful not to twist sts. Purl 1 rnd.

**Setup Rnd:** K25, PM, k41, PM, k25, PM, k41.

**Pattern Rnd:** \*Work 25 sts in Beehive Lace st, sl m, k to m, sl m; rep from \* once more.

Cont as established, working the Beehive Lace sts in lace and the k sts in k, until 9 total rnds have been worked.

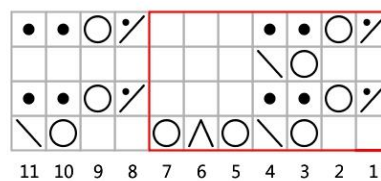
**Dec Rnd:** \*Work 25 sts in Beehive Lace st, sl m, ssk, k to 2 sts before m, k2tog, sl m; rep from \* once more—4 sts dec’d. 128 sts on needle. Rep the dec rnd every 10th rnd 3 times more—12 sts dec’d. 116 sts remain.

Work even until piece measures 9” from CO edge. BO all sts in p on next rnd. Weave in all ends. Block to measurements.

ABBREVIATIONS: BO= bind off, CO= cast on, cont= continue, dec= decrease, inc= increase, K= knit, K2tog= knit two together, m= marker, mm= millimeter, P=purl, p2tog= purl two together, PM=place marker. Pssso= pass slipped stitch over, Rep=repeat, rnd= round RS: right side, sl= slip, SSK=slip, slip, knit these two stitches together, St(s)=stitch(es), tog=together, WS=wrong side, YO=yarn over
