

CUZCO CASHMERE
Thistle Scarf



Approx. Finished Size: 6 x 72”

Materials:

Cuzco Cashmere: 2 – 50g balls, color 12--
Blush

Gauge: 5.5 sts = 1” on size 6 needle over st st
before blocking.

Needles: Size US 6.

Pattern Rows:

Row 1 and all other wrong-side rows (WS): K3,
P31, K3.

Row 2: K3, (ssk) twice, *(yo,k1) 3 times, yo, k2
tog, sl 1 – k2 tog – pssso, ssk; rep from *, end (yo,
k1) 3 times yo, (k2 tog) twice, k3.

Row 4: K3, ssk, *k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, sl 1 – k2 tog –
pssso; rep from *, end k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, k2 tog.,
k3.

Row 6: K3, ssk, *k2, yo, k3, yo, k2, sl 1 – k2 tog –
pssso; rep from *, end k2, yo k3, yo, k2, k2 tog, k3.

Row 8: K3, ssk, *k1, yo, k5, yo, k1, sl 1 – k2 tog –
pssso; rep from *, end k1, yo, k5, yo, k1, k2 tog,
k3.

Row 10: K3, ssk, *yo, k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2 tog, yo,
k1, yo, sl 1 – k2 tog – pssso; rep from *, end last
repeat k2 tog instead of sl1 – k2 tog – pssso, k3.

Row 12: K3, ssk, *yo, k2, yo, sl 1 – k2 tog – pssso;
rep from *, end yo, k2, yo, k2 tog, k3.

Row 14: K4, *yo, k3, sl 1 - k2 tog – pssso, k3, yo,
k1; rep from *, k3.

Row 16: K4, *yo, k1, yo, k2 tog, sl 1 – k2 tog –
pssso, ssk, (yo, k1) twice; rep from *, end k3.

Row 18: K4, *yo, k3, sl 1 - k2 tog – pssso, k3, yo,
k1; rep from *, end k3.

Row 20: K5, *yo, k2, sl 1 – k2 tog – pssso, k2, yo,
k3; rep from *, end last repeat K5.

Row 22: K6, *yo, k1, sl 1 – k2 tog – pssso, k1, yo,

k5; rep from * , end last repeat k6.

Row 24: K4, *k2 tog, yo, k1, yo, sl 1 – k2 tog – pssso, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k1; rep from *, k3.

Row 26: K3, ssk, *yo, k2, yo, sl 1 – k2 tog – pssso; rep from *, end yo, k2, yo, k2 tog, k3.

Row 28: K3, ssk, *k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, sl 1 – k2 tog – pssso; rep from *, end k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, k2 tog., k3.

Repeat Rows 1-28 for pattern.

With size 6 needles, cast on 37 sts. Start pattern rows and knit until desired length.

Knit 5 rows in garter stitch (knit every row) and bind off. Block to size.

ABBREVIATIONS: dec = decrease, inc = increase, RS= right side, sl = slip, st(s) = stitch(es), tbl = through back loop, tog = together, WS = Wrong Side, yo = yarn over, pssso = pass slipped st over, k2tog = knit 2 sts together, p = purl, k = knit, ssk = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together in that position, sl = slip.
