

**Calico & Calico Jakar from Nako  
Chemo Caps**



**Rolled Brim Hat**

**Size:** Child's small( Child's Large, Ladies)

**Materials:** 1—100g ball of Calico Jakar. Shown in color 1880 light rose.

**Needles:** 16" circular needle size US 5, plus same size double pointed needles; and 1 stitch marker.

**Gauge:** 5.5 stitches = 1 inch. **GET GAUGE!!**

With circular needles, loosely cast on 80 (90, 100) sts. Place marker, and join being careful not to twist the stitches. Work in stockinette stitch (knit every round) until total length is 5.5 (6.5, 7)" ending at the marker. On the next round, begin decreasing as follows: Change to double points when needed.

Round 1: \*(Knit 8, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 2: \*(Knit 7, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 3: \*(Knit 6, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 4: \*(Knit 5, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 5: \*(Knit 4, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 6: \*(Knit 3, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 7: \*(Knit 2, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 8: \*(Knit 1, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 9: \*(K2tog); repeat from \* around.

Cut the yarn leaving a 12" tail, thread it through the remaining stitches, draw up tightly and secure.

Weave in all ends.

Abbreviations: Ch = chain; dc = double crochet; sl st = slip stitch; YO = yarn over, Fpdc = front post double crochet (YO, insert hook from front to back around post of the next st, YO and pull up a loop and complete as a dc).

Bpdc = back post double crochet (YO, insert hook from back to front around post of next st, YO and pull up a loop and complete as a dc). ; K = knit, p = purl, st(s) = stitch(es); k2tog = knit 2 sts together.

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**Eyelet Rolled Brim Hat**

**Size:** Child's large or ladies small (ladies medium, ladies x-large)

**Materials:** 1—100g ball Calico shown in color 331 mint

**Needles:** 16" circular size US 5, plus same size double pointed needles; and 1 stitch marker.

**Gauge:** 5.5 stitches = 1 inch.

**Eyelet pattern:**

Round 1: K5, \*[k2tog, yo, k6]; repeat from \* to last 3 sts, end k2tog, yo, k1.

Round 2: Knit.

Round 3: K4, \*[k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo, k4]; repeat from \* to last 4 sts, end k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo.

Round 4: Knit.

Round 5: Knit.

Round 6: Knit.

Round 7: Knit.

Round 8: Knit.

Round 9: K1, \*[k2tog, yo, k6]; repeat from \* to last 7 sts, end k2tog, yo, k5.

Round 10: Knit.

Round 11: \*[K2tog, yo, k2tog, yo, k4]; repeat from \* to end of round.

Round 12: Knit.

Round 13: Knit.

Round 14: Knit.

Round 15: Knit.

Round 16: Knit.

Repeat these 16 rounds to form eyelet pattern.

With circular needle, loosely cast on 88 (96, 104) sts. Place marker, and join being careful not to twist the stitches. Work in stockinette stitch (knit every round) for 10, (10, 12, 12) rounds then work in eyelet pattern until total length is 5.5, (6.5, 7)", ending by working a knit round **other than** 2 or 10. On the next round, begin decreasing as follows, beginning with decrease round: 3 (2, 1). Change to double points when needed.

Round 1: \*(Knit 11, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 2: \*(Knit 10, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 3 \*(Knit 9, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 4: \*(Knit 8, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 5: \*(Knit 7, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 6: \*(Knit 6, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 7: \*(Knit 5, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 8: \*(Knit 4, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 9: \*(Knit 3, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 10: \*(Knit 2, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 11: \*(Knit 1, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 12: \*(K2tog); repeat from \* around.

Cut the yarn leaving a 12" tail, thread it through the remaining stitches, draw up tightly and secure.

Weave in all ends.

Find Inspiration: [www.plymouthyarn.com](http://www.plymouthyarn.com)**Crochet Popcorn Hat****Size:** Ladies Medium**Materials:** 1—100g ball Calico shown in color 1638 light pink**Hook:** Hook Size G.**Gauge:** 4 dc = 1".**Begin:**Ch 6, join with sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3, do 11 dc in ring ; join with sl st in top of ch 3. (12 dc)

Rnd 2: Ch 3, dc in same st; \* 2dc in next st.; repeat from \* around; join with sl st in top of ch 3. (24 dc)

Rnd 3: Ch 3, dc in same st; \* dc in next st; 2 dc in the next st; repeat from \* around, ending with a dc in last st. Join with sl st in top of ch 3. (36 dc)

Rnd 4: Ch 3, dc in same st; \* dc in next 2 st; 2 dc in the next st; repeat from \* around, ending with a dc in last 2 sts. Join with sl st in top of ch 3. (48 dc)

Rnd 5: Ch 3, dc in same st; \* dc in next 3 sts; 2 dc in the next st; repeat from \* around, ending with a dc in last 3 sts. Join with sl st in top of ch 3. (60 dc)

Rnd 6: Ch 3, dc in same st; \*dc in next 4 sts; 2 dc in the next st; repeat from \* around, ending with a dc in last 4 sts. Join with sl st in top of ch 3. (72 dc)

Rnds 7- 15: **NOTE: Work Popcorn round on round 14.** Ch 3, dc in each st; join with sl st in top of ch 3. (72dc)Rnd 16: Ch 2, do a fpdc around the post of the dc below the ch 2; \* bpdc around post of next dc; fpdc around post of next dc; repeat from \* around. Join with sl st around post of 1<sup>st</sup> fpdc.Rnd 17: Ch 2, fpdc around the post of the fpdc below the ch 2; (this is the same st you slip stitched around to join the previous round) ; \*bpdc around post of next bpdc; fpdc around post of next fpdc; repeat from \* around. Join with sl st around post of 1<sup>st</sup> fpdc.

Rnd 18: Repeat Rnd 17. Join with sl st and finish off.

Popcorn Stitch = Ch 3, dc in next 2 sts \* 4dc in next st, drop loop from hook, insert hook into 1<sup>st</sup> st , pick up dropped loop and pull thru, dc in next 3 st, repeat from \* around. Make sure there are 72 sts after this round.

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
