Team/Holiday Hat **Encore Starz**



Size: Adult.

Materials: 1 each —100g Encore Starz in color A & B. 2 hats can be knit from the 2 balls of Encore Starz. Shown in color G204 & G999 for Holiday version, G204 & G194 for Team version

Needles: 16" circular size US 5, 16" circular size US 7, double pointed needles size US 7, 1 stitch marker.

Gauge: 20 sts =4" over st st on larger needles.

K2- p2 ribbing: *(K2, p2); repeat from *around. Repeat this round for all rounds of ribbing.

Begin

With Color A, and smaller circular needle, loosely cast on 88 sts. Place marker and join, making sure not to twist the sts. Work in k2- p2 ribbing for 2", increasing 12 sts evenly across last round: 100 sts.

Change to larger circular needle and continuing with color A, work 2 rounds in st st.

Note: When working the upcoming striped section, carry the unused color loosely up the inside.

Attach color B and work 2 rounds in st st.

Change to color A and work 2 rounds in st st.

Change to color B and work 2 rounds in st st.

Change to color A and work 2 rounds in st st. Cut Grey.

Continue with color B, working in st st until total length is 8", ending at the marker.

Begin decreases, changing to double pointed needles when needed.

Round 1: *(K8, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 2: Knit even.

Round 3: *(K7, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 4: *(K6, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 5: *(K5, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 6: *(K4, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 7: *(K3, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 8: *(K2, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 9: *(K1, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 10: *(K2tog); repeat from * around. 10 sts remain.

Cut yarn and thread through remaining sts. Pull up tight and fasten off. Weave in all ends.

Using color A, make a large Pom-pon and attach securely at the top.
