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# Viento **Crochet More Than A Hood**



# **Materials:**

Viento: 3–50g skeins, shown in

color 01

**Hook:** Crochet Hook I-9 (5.5mm)

Pins for marking

Gauge: 12 DCs and 6.5 rows in

pattern = 4"

This generous hood starts at the top of the head and is worked to the neck where a scarf grows out of a mini shaped yoke.

CH 29. Insert hook into the second CH from the hook and SC to the end. Do not turn but continue on the other side of the CH and SC to the end. CH 2 and turn.

Row 1: DC in each SC to the end of the row. CH 2 and turn.

Row 2: DC in each DC to the end of the row. CH 2 and turn.

Repeat Row 2 until hood measures 9" from the initial CH and end the row with CH1 and turn.

## Neck area:

First Decreasing Row: \*2 SCs, decrease 1 stitch in the next 2 stitches. Repeat from \* to the end of the row working SCs in any remaining stitches. CH 2 and

DC in each stitch to the end. CH 1 and

Second Decreasing Row: \* 4 SCs, decrease1 stitch in the next 2 stitches.

Repeat from \* to the end of the row, working SCs in any remaining stitches. Fasten off.

Fold the hood in half and place a pin at the center back, noting that there are the same number of stitches on either side of the pin. If there is an odd number, both sides will be worked into the marked stitch.

#### **Right Front:**

Insert the hook into the marked stitch and CH 1. SC in each stitch to the front and CH 29. Turn.

Row 1: Insert the hook into the 3rd CH from the hook. DC in each CH and in the SCs to the marked stitch. CH 1 and turn.

Row 2: (SC in the next 2 DCs, 2 SCs in the next DC.) 5 times. SC to the end of the row. CH 2 and turn.

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Row 3: DC in each SC to the end of the row. CH 1 and turn.

Row 4: (SC in the next 3 DCs, 2 SCs in the next DC) 5 times. SC to the end of the row. CH 2 and turn.

Row 5: 19 DCs, skip 6 DCs, CH 6 and DC to the end of the row. CH 1 and turn.

Row 6: (SC in the next 4 DCs, 2 SCs in the next DC) 5 times, SC in each DC and CH to the end of the row. CH 2 and turn.

Row 7: DC in each SC to the end of the row. CH 1 and turn.

Row 8: (SC in the next 5 DCs, 2 SCs in the next DC) 5 times. SC to the end of the row. CH 1 and turn.

Row 9: DC in each SC to the end of the row. CH 1 and turn.

Row 10: (SC in the next 6 DCs, 2 SCs in the next DC) 4 times. SC to the end of the row. Fasten off.

### **Left Front:**

CH 28. Insert hook into the first DC on the left side of the hood and SC in each stitch along the bottom of the hood to the marked stitch.

Row 1: (DC in the next 2 SCs, 2 DCs in the next SC) 5 times. DC to the end of the bottom of the hood and the CH stitches. CH 1 and turn.

Row 2: SC in each DC to the end of the row. CH 2 and turn.

Row 3: (DC in the next 3 SCs, 2 DCs in the next SC) 5 times. DC to the end of the row. CH 1 and turn.

Row 4: SC in each DC to the end of the row. CH 2 and turn.

Row 5: (DC in the next 4 SCs, 2 DCs in the next SC) 5 times. DC in each SC and CH to the end of the row. CH 1 and turn

Row 6: SC in each DC to the end of the row. CH 2 and turn.

Row 7: (DC in the next 5 SCs, 2 DCs in the next SC) 5 times. DC to the end of the row, CH 1 and turn.

Row 8: SC in each DC to the end of the row. CH 2 and turn.

Row 9: (DC in the next 6 SCs, 2 DCs in the next SC) 4 times. DC to the end of the row. CH 1 and turn.

Row 10: SC in each DC to the end of the row. Fasten off.

**Note:** Our sample had ample yarn to work all 10 rows. If you are running short, just stop at 8 rows.

#### **Finishing**

Sew seam joining the right and left sides at the back of the section below the hood.

Work 1 row of SC around the front of the hood. Try working 3 SCs in every 2 rows of DC for a smooth edge.

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
