

Bon Ton from Adriafile Diagonal Lace Cowl



Materials: 2 balls Bon Ton by Adriafile shown in color 85, waste cotton.

Needles: 1 set US 5 needles

Size: 10" x 38" after blocking.

Gauge: 22 sts = 4" in stockinette stitch

Pattern Notes:

sl1-k2-ssso: Slip one stitch, knit the next 2 sts, pass the slipped stitch over the 2 knit sts.

Directions:

With a provisional cast on, cast on 64 sts.

Work 1 WS row: K4, p56, k4.

Begin working lace pattern:

Row 1(RS): K3, *[yo, sl1-k2-ssso]; repeat from * to last 4 sts, end k4.

Row 2(WS): K4, p56, k4

Row 3: K4, *[yo, sl1-k2-ssso]; repeat from * to last 3 sts, end k3.

Row 4: Same as row 2

Row 5: K5, *[yo, sl1-k2-ssso]; repeat from * to last 2 sts, end k2.

Row 6: Same as row 2.

Repeat Rows 1-6 until scarf is desired length or just 2 yards of yarn left. End with a WS row.

Remove provisional cast on and place sts on a second needle.

Kitchener st these beginning sts to the sts on the first needle.

Weave in ends securely. Block out severely to get desired length.

ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CO= cast on, dec= decrease, DPNs= double pointed needles, inc= increase, k= knit, k2tog= knit two stitches together, m= marker, mm= millimeter, m1 = Make 1 st by lifting the bar between last st and next st and working l to the back of it, PM= place marker, p = purl, pssso= pass slipped stitch over, rep= repeat, rnd= round, RS= right side, sl = slip, ssk = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st.
