PLYMOUTH BAY Crochet Hat



Approximate Size: Adult

Materials:

Plymouth Bay: 1 – 200g skein, shown in color 8 Teal

Hook/Notions: P or Q (15mm), pins for marking, tapestry needle with a large hole

CH 27.

Being careful not to twist the line of chains, work a SC in the first CH connecting to make a foundation for the hat.

Continue to work SCs in each CH. When you come to the place where you began the connection, simply continue working SCs around and around. Mark the beginning of the rounds with a pin and carry this pin up as you go.

When work measures 7", begin to decrease for the crown as follows:

Decrease in SC: Insert hook into the next st and pull up a loop, insert into the next st and pull up a loop. YO and go through the 3 loops.

Round 1: SC in next 2 SCs. Decrease. 6 times

Round 2: SC in next SC. Decrease. 6 times

Round 3 to end: Decrease every stitch until the hole at the top is nearly closed up. Fasten off leaving 8" of yarn. With a tapestry needle close up the hole and weave in the end on the inside of the hat. Work the yarn at the beginning into the inside of the hat, trying to minimize the gap as you joined the foundation chain.
