

**ELECTRA LITE  
Patterned Scarf**



**Finished Dimensions (blocked): 10½ x 65”**

There is plenty of yarn to make this scarf longer than shown.

**Materials:**

**Electra Lite: 1 - 100g skeins, color 7 Amethyst**

**Gauge:** 16 sts = 4” on US size 9 (5.5mm) needles over pattern before blocking.

**Needles:** US Size 9 (5.5mm) or size needed to obtain gauge.

Loosely cast on 67 sts.

Knit 4 rows.

Begin pattern, keeping the first 3 sts and last 3 sts as knit sts on every row as follows:

Row 1: K3, k2tog, \*(k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, slip 2 sts together as if to k2tog, k1, pass the 2 slipped sts over the knitted st); repeat from \* to last 12 sts, k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, ssk, k3.

Row 2: K3, purl to last 3 sts, k3.

Repeat rows 1 & 2 for pattern until piece measures 64” or until almost out of yarn, ending with a Row 2.

Purl 4 rows.

Loosely bind off purlwise. Weave in ends.

Block out.

Optional Fringe: Cut about 42 strands of Electra Lite each 15” long. Holding 3 strands together attach at points along each end of scarf - each about 3” apart, or as desired. Trim.

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
