Sea Isle Cotton Diagonal Lace Cowl

Materials:

Sea Isle Cotton—1--- 100g hank shown in color 6-Robin, waste cotton for provisional cast on.

Gauge: 18 sts = 4" over st st.

Needles: US Size 8.

Size: 8" x 40" around

Pattern Notes:

sl1-k2-ssso: Slip one stitch, knit the next 2 sts, pass the slipped stitch over the 2 knit sts.

Directions:

With a provisional cast on, cast on 47 sts. Work one WS row: K3, p41, k3.

Begin working lace pattern:

Row 1(RS): K2, *[yo, sl1-k2-ssso]; repeat from * to last 3 sts, end k3.

Row 2(WS): K3, p41, k3

Row 3: K3, *[yo, sl1-k2-ssso]; repeat from * to last 2 sts, end k2.

Row 4: Same as row 2

Row 5: K4, *[yo, sl1-k2-ssso]; repeat from * to last st, end k1.

Row 6: Same as row 2.

Repeat Rows 1-6 until piece is desired length or just 2 yards of yarn left. End with a WS row.

Remove provisional cast on and place sts on a second needle. Kitchener st these beginning sts to the sts on the first needle.

Weave in ends securely. Block out if desired.

Abbreviations: K – knit, p - purl, st(s) – stitch(es), sl – slip, pssso – pass the slipped st over, RS – right side, WS – wrong side, yo – yarn over.
