YAKIMA Spiral Rib Cowl



Finished Measurements: Circumference: 24" (after

blocking) **Length:** 12"

Materials:

 $\overline{\text{Yakima: }}1 - 100g \text{ skein shown}$

in color 201 Crimson

Needles/Notions: US Size 5 – 24" circular needle, stitch

marker

Gauge: 24 sts and 34 rows = 4" in stst on US size 5 needle

Broad Spiral Rib Pattern Stitch:

Rounds 1 and 3: **[P2, *(k4, p2); repeat from * one time, k10]; repeat from ** around.

Round 2: **[P2, *(k2tog but do not slip from needle; insert right hand needle between the sts just knitted together and knit the first st again; then slip both sts from the needle) twice; p2) repeat from * once more, k10]; repeat from ** around.

Round 4: **[P2, *(k1, k2tog and knit first st again as before, k1, p2); repeat from * one time, k10]; repeat from ** around.

Loosely cast on 168 sts.

Place stitch marker and join, being careful not to twist the stitches.

Abbreviations: K = knit, P = purl, St(s) = stitch(es), tog = together, stst = stockinette stitch

<u>Repeat rounds 1-4 of the Broad Spiral Rib Pattern Stitch until total length</u> is about 12", ending with round 4 of the Broad Spiral Rib Pattern Stitch. Bind off loosely in pattern. Weave in all ends.
