## YAKIMA <br> Spiral Rib Cowl



## Finished Measurements:

Circumference: 24" (after blocking)
Length: 12"

## Materials:

Yakima: $1-100 \mathrm{~g}$ skein shown in color 201 Crimson
Needles/Notions: US Size 5 24 " circular needle, stitch marker
Gauge: 24 sts and 34 rows $=$ 4 " in stst on US size 5 needle

## Broad Spiral Rib Pattern Stitch:

Rounds 1 and 3: **[P2, *(k4, p2); repeat from * one time, k10]; repeat from ** around. Round 2: **[P2, *(k2tog but do not slip from needle; insert right hand needle between the sts just knitted together and knit the first st again; then slip both sts from the needle) twice; p2) repeat from * once more, k10]; repeat from ** around.

Round 4: **[P2, *(k1, k2tog and knit first st again as before, $\mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p} 2)$; repeat from * one time, k10]; repeat from ** around.

Loosely cast on 168 sts.
Place stitch marker and join, being careful not to twist the stitches.

Repeat rounds 1-4 of the Broad Spiral Rib Pattern Stitch until total length is about 12", ending with round 4 of the Broad Spiral Rib Pattern Stitch. Bind off loosely in pattern. Weave in all ends.
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Abbreviations: $\mathrm{K}=\mathrm{knit}, \mathrm{P}=$ purl, $\mathrm{St}(\mathrm{s})=$ stitch $(\mathrm{es})$, $\operatorname{tog}=$ together, stst $=$ stockinette stitch
