

Free Pattern with Our Compliments

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TUSSAH KISSED Shawl

Approximate Finished Dimensions:
56" wingspan, 21½" back length

Materials:

Tussah Kissed: 1—100g hank each colors

106 Grey (CC) and 109 Mauve (MC)

Gauge: 18 sts = 4" in st st US Size 4 (3.5mm) needle
after blocking.

Needles/Notions: US Size 4 (3.5mm)- 32" circular
knitting needle, 2 stitch markers, blocking pins

Special Abbreviation

PSO= pass the first of the three knit stitch over the
second and third (1 stitch decreased).

Begin

Setup

With CC, CO 5 sts.

Row 1 (WS): K2, p1, k2.

Row 2 (RS): K2, yo, k1, yo, k2—2 sts inc'd. 7 sts on
needle.

Row 3: K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 4: K2, yo, k1, yo, pm, k1, pm, yo, k1, yo, k2—4 sts
inc'd. 11 sts on needle.

Section 1

Row 1 (WS): K to m, sl m, p1, sl m, k to end.

Row 2 (RS): K2, yo, k to m, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k to
last 2 sts, yo, k2—4 sts inc'd.

Row 3: K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

Rows 4-5: Rep rows 2 and 3.

Row 6: Rep row 2. 23 sts on needle.

Work these 6 rows 6 times more. Then work Row 1 once more. 95 sts on needle.

Section 2

Row 1 (RS): CC: K2, yo, k to m, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2—4 sts inc'd.

Row 2 (WS): CC: K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

Rows 3-4: Rep rows 1 and 2.

Row 5: MC: K2, yo, k to m, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2—4 sts inc'd. 107 sts on needle.

Row 6: MC: K to m, sl m, p1, sl m, k to end.

Work these 6 rows 4 times more (you can loosely carry the non-working yarn up the side of the work instead of cutting it), then work rows 1-4 once more.

Then work row 1. Cut MC, leaving a 6" tail for weaving in. 167 sts on needle.



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Find Inspiration: www.plymouthyarn.comSection 3Row 1 (WS): MC: K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.Row 2 (RS): MC: K2, yo, k2, *yo, k3, PSO; rep from * to 1 st before m, k1, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k1, *k3, PSO, yo; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, yo, k2—4 sts inc'd.Row 3: CC: K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.Row 4: CC: K2, yo, k2, *yo, k3, PSO; rep from * to m, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, *k3, PSO, yo; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, yo, k2—4 sts inc'd.Row 5: MC: K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.Row 6: MC: K2, yo, k2, *yo, k3, PSO; rep from * to 2 sts before m, k2, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k2, *k3, PSO, yo; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, yo, k2—4 sts inc'd.Row 7: CC: K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.Row 8: CC: K2, yo, k2, *yo, k3, PSO; rep from * to 1 st before m, k1, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k1, *k3, PSO, yo; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, yo, k2—4 sts inc'd. 183 sts on needle.

Rep these 8 rows 2 times more. Cut CC, leaving a 6" tail for weaving in. 215 sts on needle.

Section 4:

With MC:

Row 1 and all WS Rows: K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.Row 2: K2, yo, k1, *yo, k1, k3tog, k1, yo, k1; rep from * to 2 sts before m, k2, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k2, *k1, yo, k1, k3tog, k1, yo; rep from * to last 3 sts, k1, yo, k2—4 sts inc'd. 219 sts on needle.Row 4: K2, yo, k2, *yo, k1, k3tog, k1, yo, k1; rep from * to 3 sts before m, k3, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k3, *k1, yo, k1, k3tog, k1, yo; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, yo, k2—4 sts inc'd. 223 sts on needle.Row 6: K2, yo, k3, *yo, k1, k3tog, k1, yo, k1; rep from * to 4 sts before m, k4, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, K4, *k1, yo, k1, k3tog, k1, yo; rep from * to last 5 sts, k3, yo, k2—4 sts inc'd. 227 sts on needle.Row 8: K2, yo, k4, *yo, k1, k3tog, k1, yo, k1; rep from * to 5 sts before m, k5, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k5, *k1, yo, k1, k3tog, k1, yo; rep from * to last 6 sts, k4, yo, k2—4 sts inc'd. 231 sts on needle.Row 10: K2, yo, k5, *yo, k1, k3tog, k1, yo, k1; rep from * to m, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, *k1, yo, k1, k3tog, k1, yo; rep from * to last 7 sts, k5, yo, k2—4 sts inc'd. 235 sts on needle.Row 12: K2, yo, k6, *yo, k1, k3tog, k1, yo, k1; rep from * to 1 st before m, k1, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k1, *k1, yo, k1, k3tog, k1, yo; rep from * to last 8 sts, k6, yo, k2—4 sts inc'd. 239 sts on needle.

Rep these 12 rows once more, then work rows 1-11. 283 sts on needle.



Bind off Row (RS): K1, *yo, k1, pass the 1st and 2nd stitch on right hand needle over the 3rd; rep from * across entire row until all sts are worked. Cut yarn, leaving a 6" tail for weaving in. Fasten off.

Finishing

Wet block the shawl by soaking it in warm water for about 10-15 minutes. Remove from the water and roll in a towel to remove excess moisture. Pin out the shawl to the finished measurements—pinning out the bind off rows' edging. Wait for it to air dry. Weave in all ends.

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
