

**SEA ISLE COTTON**  
**Buttoned Cocoon/Shrug**



**Approx. Finished Size:** 21" x 50"

**Materials:**

**Sea Isle Cotton:** 3 – 100g hank, shown in color 11 Sand Dollar

**Gauge:** 16 sts = 4" on a US 9 needle over garter st.

**Needles:** US 9 & 10.5 for bind off only, or size necessary to get gauge. 10 buttons

With size 9 needle, loosely cast on 200 sts. Knit every row until total length is 2.5".

Next row: Work first set of buttonholes as follows: \*(K10, k2tog, yo); repeat from \* 4 more times- 5 buttonholes.

Continue to knit across row to end. Knit every row until total length is 18.5".

Next row: Buttonholes: Knit across until 60 sts remain, \*\*(yo, k2tog, k10); repeat from \*\* to end of row.- 5 buttonholes on each side.

Remaining rows: Knit every row until total length is 21".

Bind off knitwise with larger needle to keep the bind off edge loose. Length & stretchiness of the bind off edge should match the cast on edge.

Weave in all ends. Sew 10 buttons to correspond to the 10 buttonholes.

Fold in half lengthwise and button the edge. 20" at the center remains open.
