

## Encore Worsted Ripple Throw



**Size:** 30 x 40" (36 x 45")

**Materials:** 1—100g ball each of 6 colors of Encore Worsted. Small throw shown in color Set A, large throw shown in color set C

**Needles:** 24" or longer circular size US 9

**Gauge:** ~ 17 sts = 4" over pattern st.

### Pattern:

Row 1(RS): K2, (k2tog) twice, \*(yo, k1) 4 times, (k2tog) 4 times, repeat from \* to last 10 sts, (yo, k1) 4 times, (k2tog) twice, k2.

Row 2(WS): K2, purl to last 2 sts, end k2.

Row 3(RS): Knit.

Row 4(WS): Knit.



**NOTES:** Set up your color sequence- A – F. You will be working 4 rows of each color, then changing to the next color. Each color change will occur at the beginning of row 3, a RS row. The 6- color sequence will be worked 9 times, or to desired length.

**Suggestion:** Work your ends in as you go, by leaving them 6" long and working them along with the working yarn for a few sts.

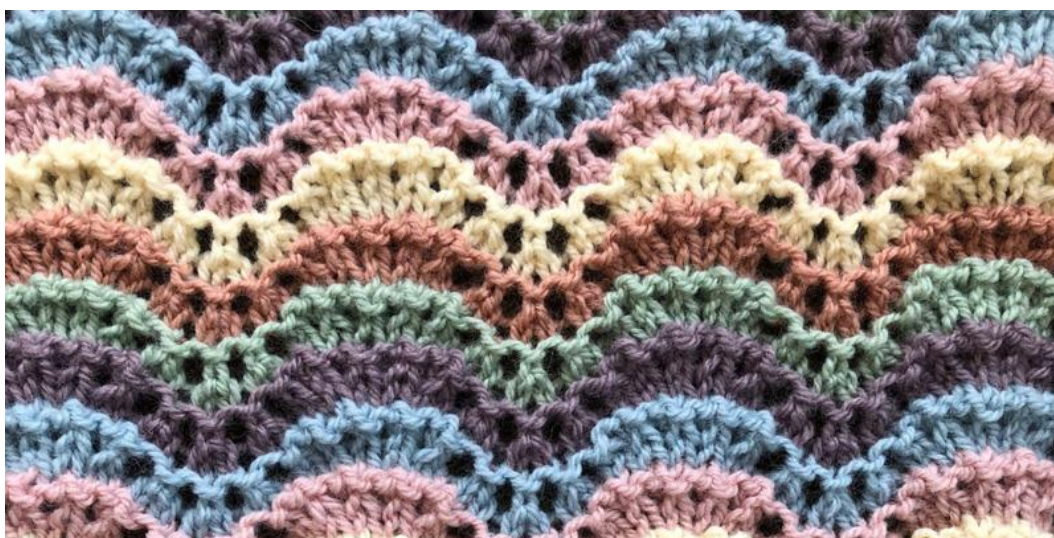
**Begin:**

With Color A, loosely cast on (124) 148 sts.

Knit 2 rows.

Begin pattern, working rows 1 and 2 in color A, then changing to color B for rows 3, 4, then 1, 2. Every time you come to row 3- change to the next color until the 6 color sequence has been worked. Then begin the 6 color sequence again with color A.

When total length is reached, end with the last color (color F, or as desired), working rows 3, 4, and 1 only. Knit 1 row (WS). Bind off loosely knitwise on the next row (a RS row). Weave in all ends.



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Abbreviations: K = knit, p = purl, yo = yarn over, k2tog = knit 2 sts together, st(s) = stitch(es), RS = right side, WS = wrong side.
